

FROM SACRAMENTO:

Take I-80 West toward San Francisco. Stay on I-80 West toward San Francisco for approximately 15 miles. Take Highway 113 North Exit (to Woodland). Take the first exit (Hutchison Drive) and bear right (east) on Hutchison. Take the second right onto LaRue Road (4-way light). Drive on LaRue until you reach a curve in the road. At the curve, turn right on Garrod Drive. Follow Garrod Drive around to the stop sign. At the stop sign, go straight into Parking Lot #50.
