Mendocino County 4-H Leaders Council will host the 2017 State 4-H Archery Match.

The following is a list of procedures and rules for participation in the 2017 State 4-H Archery Match

1. The registration process is as follows: All Tulare County 4-H registration forms must be sent to the Tulare County 4-H Office, 4437-B S. Laspina Street, Tulare, CA 93274 Each clubs' registration check shall be made out to Tulare County 4-H Leader's Council (TC 4-H LC) and should cover the total number of category entries times the entry fee of \$5 per category entry. **Registration forms and payment are due to the Tulare County 4-H Office by 5:00 pm on Thursday, April 13<sup>th</sup>.**

The county 4-H Youth Development Advisor, 4-H Program Representative or other UCCE 4-H staff authorized individual shall sign the registration form to **verify that all entrants, adults and youth** are currently enrolled in 4-H.

2. After receiving and processing the registration packets from your county, labeled targets and score sheets will be mailed to the participating shooting sports leaders.
3. A California 4-H State Archery certified Shooting Sports Leader must supervise all shooting. For more information on becoming certified in the various disciplines, go to <http://ca4h.org/Projects/SET/ShootingSports/>
4. After scoring the match, return the score sheets to UCCE Mendocino no later than **June 27, 2017**. No late returns will be accepted. The results will be compiled and distributed through the UCCE offices.
5. **NEW** this year..... 1<sup>st</sup> time shooters, all ages, all categories, will shoot at 10 yards. This is only for **FIRST TIME SHOOTERS**. Please send in the FIRST TIME ONLY shooters entry form.
