AGE DIVISIONS: (age as of December 31, 2022)

Junior = J	Intermediate = I	Senior = S

All participants will be verified as being currently enrolled in the 4-H YDP, by the Tulare County UCCE 4-H Office.

CLASS CODES: Youth may enter as many classes as they would like, according to their 4-H project enrollment.

01 = .22 Rifle Open Sight	03 = Shotgun Trap	05 = .22 Handgun (Pistol)
02 = .22 Rifle Peep Sight	04 = Shotgun Skeet	

AWARDS:

Ribbons will be awarded for $1^{st} - 5^{th}$ place. Individual awards will be awarded to the top 3 individuals in each age division in each class.

GENERAL RULES:

All targets must be shot in the presence of a certified 4-H Project Leader for the specific discipline. For the Shotgun, Pistol, and Archery disciplines, all scorecards MUST be signed by one scorekeeper and one leader from the discipline as verification. Youth members do NOT sign their scorecards. All scorecards and fired rifle targets must be returned to the 4-H Office by the due date.





Rifle Contest Rules:

20 shots will be fired in a time limit of 20 minutes on 2 Orion A-17 targets, one shot per minute. Both targets should be posted side-by-side and shot in 20 minutes. Firing MUST be done under the supervision of the California 4-H YDP Certified Shooting Sports Rifle Project Leader for the club. NRA Smallbore Rifle Rules will apply https://competitions.nra.org/media/7745/nra-smallbore-rifle-rules.pdf Any Rifle as defined in NRA Rule 3.1. may be used. NRA Rule 10.1.6 shall not apply, allowing loading from a magazine. No telescopic sights allowed. Open sights or Peep sights must be used. Shooters must compete with the type of sights they registered with. The Orion A17 target will be used with one shot to be fired on each scoring bull at 50 feet. No sighting shots will be taken, (in the center of the target). Any target with more than 10 shots will be scored using the 10 lowest scoring hits. External crossfires will be scored as misses. The targets are brittle so it is recommended that push pins be used rather than staples. Do not make any marks below the line on the targets and do not attempt to score targets. Marked or plugged targets will not be scored.

Shotgun Contest Rules:

American Skeet: Two rounds of skeet will be shot for a total of 50 targets. NSSA rules will apply http://www.nssa-nsca.org/wp-content/uploads/2012/03/2013-NSSA-Rule-Book.pdf Scores shall be recorded on the provided score sheet.

American Trap: Two rounds of singles (16 yard) trap will be shot for a total of 50 targets. The ATA Rule Book of the Amateur Trapshooting Association will be used http://www.shootata.com/Content/About_The_ATA/ATA_Rule_Book.aspx Scores shall be recorded on the provided score sheet and MUST be signed by one scorekeeper and one leader from the discipline as verification.

Pistol Contest Rules:

Ten shots will be fired on each target. There will be four targets. The distance is 50 feet. All targets will be fired in the standing position. A 2-handed grip will be allowed in all divisions. The NRA Pistol Rules will be used. B-2 targets will be used. Scores shall be recorded on the provided score sheet and MUST be signed by one scorekeeper and one leader from the discipline as verification.
