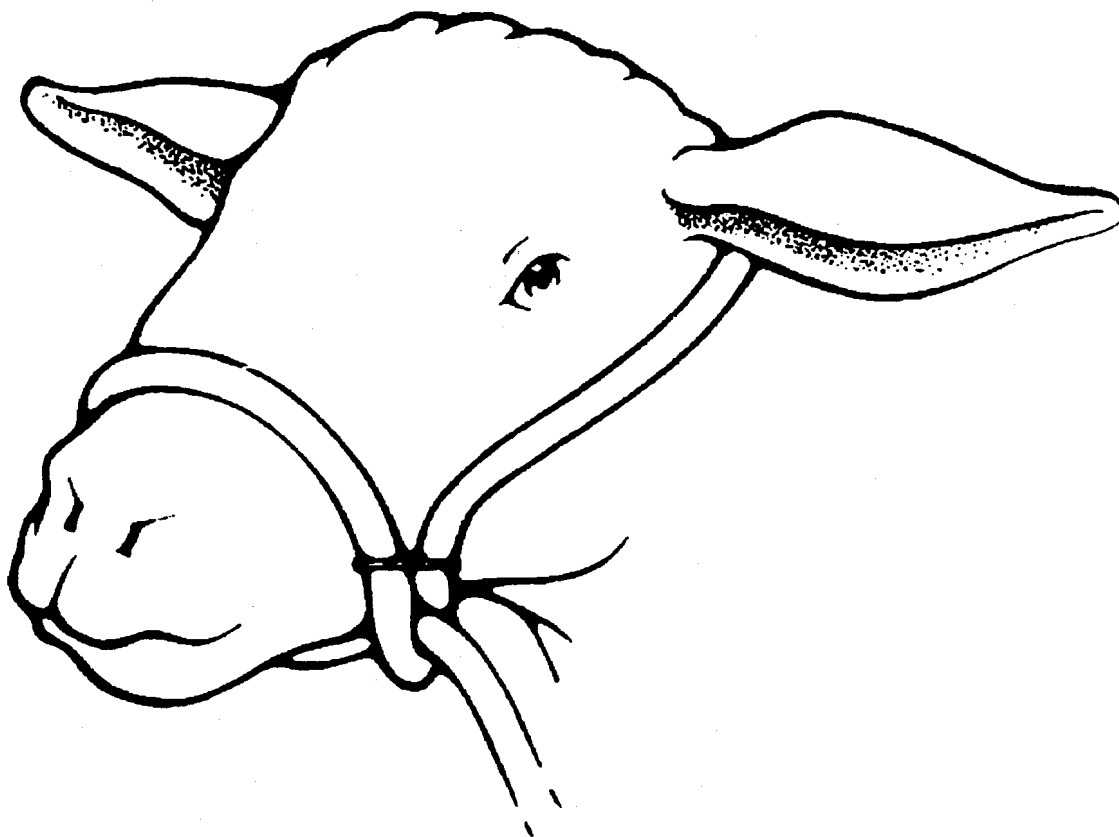

LAMB HALTER

Material :

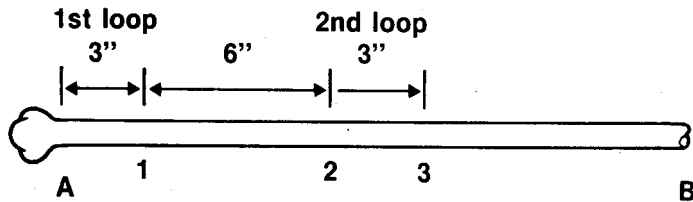
Seven feet of 1/4" polyurethane rope or synthetic fiber rope.

Two twisted chain links sized to rope.

Directions :

Step 1

Mark one end of the rope end A. As the drawing illustrates, mark the rope starting from end A at 3", 6" and 3".

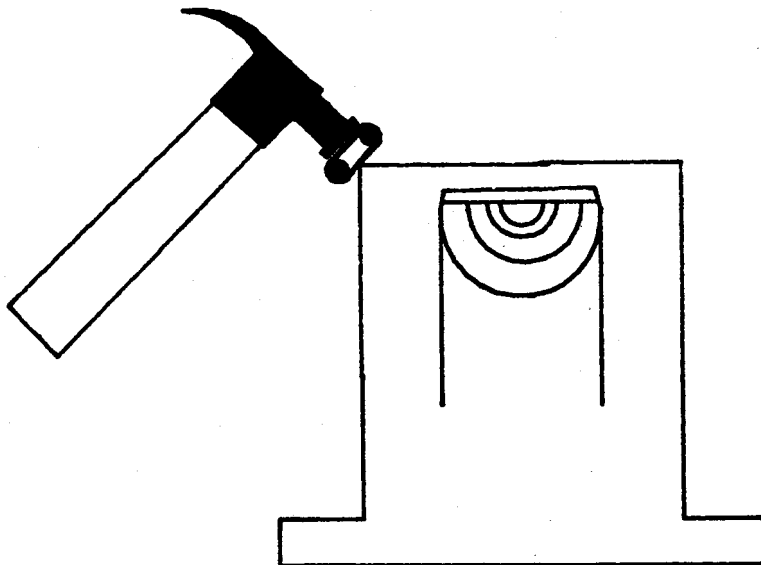


Step 2

Double end A over and slide it through the chain link. Put the link on marks #3 and #2 creating a loop.

Step 3

Using a hammer and a hard surface, clamp the chain link down on the rope until the rope can't be pulled through the link.



Step 4

Repeat step 2 with the second link. Put the second link on mark #1 and on the inside edge of the end of the rope. Once the loop is made, burn the end.

Step 5

Again, using a hammer and a hard surface, clamp the link down on the rope. The piece between the loops is the top of the nosepiece.

Step 6

Now thread end B through the first loop, then the second loop. This part of the rope will be the bottom of the nosepiece. Remember, you want the lead rope on the left side of the animal.
