Autumn Wings	Cucurbita pepo v. Ovifera	Crooked or straight, unique looking medium-sized, pear-shaped gourds
		in various colors and patterns; not recommended for culinary use.
Crown of Thorns	Cucurbita pepo	Crown-shaped, tri-colored fruits in gold, green, orange, white, and
		yellow. 4"-5" in diameter, great for decorative autumn arrangements.
Small Gourds		Hard-shelled, non-edible fruits suitable for decorative ornaments.

Bee Balm	Monarda	Perennial that attracts bees, butterflies, and hummingbirds. Vibrant
		flower heads are full of tubular petals.
Black sage	Salvia mellifera	Small, dark green, resinous leaves and numerous pale lavender
		flowers.
California Bee Plant	Scrophularia californica	Perennial with very small red to maroon flowers, extremely attractive
		to bees,
California Fuchsia	Epilobium canum	Native to CA foothills and coastal areas. Perennial with bright scarlet
		flowers.
California Goldenrod	Solidago velutina	Perennial herb in northern, southern and central CA. Birds and
	ssp.californica	pollinating insects love it.
Hummingbird Sage	Salvia spathacea	Blooming sage favored by pollinators
Purple Haze California Aster	Aster chilense 'Purple	1" medium-lavender daisies open from dark purple buds; grows 1'-3'
	Haze'	tall and spreads vigorously by rhizomes.
Red-flowered Buckwheat	Eriogonum grande var	Rosy-colored flower clusters and low-growing foliage. Flowers attract
	rubescens	a variety of pollinators.

Nasturtium	Tropaeolum majus	Edible flowers have a peppery bite
Nasturtium, Tip Top Alaska	Tropaeolum minus	Compact plant, edible variegated leaves and salmon-colored flowers

Nasturtium, trailing	Tropaeolum majus	Larger blooms and leaves than bush varieties, but fewer flowers.
Spanish Lavender 'Silver	Lavendula stoechas	Compact lavender with silver foliage and dark violet flowers. Disease
Anouk'		resistant and durable.
Spider Plant	Chlorophytum comosum	Easy to grow houseplant; propagates itself.
White Yarrow	Achillea millefolium	Perennial wildflower producing abundance of huge, flat clusters of creamy
		white flowers.
