4. <u>Recruitment:</u>

Provide multiple opportunities for interested teachers to enroll or re-enroll. Discuss challenges with supervisor as it relates to program compliance issues.

- a. Priority sites:
 - i. Schools with teachers enrolled are the priority for recruitment.
 - ii. Make every effort to recruit as many teachers at each school as possible to maximize environmental impact, increase efficiency, and reduce cost.
 - iii. This includes elementary, transitional kinder, and preschool lead teachers.
 - iv. We do not currently serve afternoon programs.
- b. Participant Agreement and Site List:
 - i. Recruit schools on the approved site list with approval from your direct supervisor.
 - ii. Schools/districts interested in participating that are not on the site list will need to be added, if they qualify.
 - iii. We will also need to obtain a Participation Agreement. In this situation, work with your supervisor to secure the agreement.
 - iv. USDA approval to add the school/district to the site list takes a minimum of 1-2 months.
 - v. The site cannot be served until USDA approval comes.
- c. Methods:
 - i. Work with school administration to determine the best method of teacher recruitment.
 - ii. The most common methods include:
 - 1. Staff meeting presentation
 - 2. Lunch time recruitment
 - 3. Recruitment during a scheduled lesson
 - 4. Recruitment through referral
- d. Who to Recruit:
 - i. In addition to educators, enroll administrators, office managers, and other support staff into the program as appropriate.
 - ii. They can record time spent doing activities that support the program, such as nutrition education delivery or administration oversight of the program at school.
 - 1. Example: putting newsletters into teacher's boxes, coordinating tasting delivery, sending reminders, etc.
- e. <u>Waiting List Process:</u>
 - i. Depending on retention and recruitment plans, at times, new school sites may be placed on a waiting list until the UC CalFresh program is able to serve the site.
 - ii. Waiting list schools will be listed on a first come, first serve basis.
 - iii. Please provide school and contact information to your Direct Supervisor.
 - iv. Overall program retention will be monitored along with program priorities and budget to determine waitlisted schools start date.
