5. Type or copy and paste blog content into the text box.

(I suggest you save on a Word document, then copy and paste in case there is a glitch.)

6. Choose picture files from your computer and insert into your post. If you do not insert them into your post they will appear at the end.

7. Tags are great ways to categorize posts on our blog. Search through existing tags before creating a new one.

(Tags can be found on the left menu of the main blog page.)

8. Click Save and Review to see what your blog will look like when published.



9. When you are satisfied with how your blog sounds and looks, hit Make Post Live. Don't panic! Your blog won't be live just yet. The Marketing Coordinator or a Supervisor will review your post before scheduling it to be published.
