
NIFA policies and procedures that apply to all NIFA awards, unless there are statutory, regulatory, or award-specific requirements to the contrary.





NIFA Federal Assistance Policy Guide (" NIFA Policy Guide")

- Single, comprehensive guidance document for NIFA grantees and staff
- Provides guidance for **competitive** and **capacity (formula)** grants
- Based on laws, regulations, USDA guidance, NIFA guidance, NIFA policy, and Administrative Manuals applicable to NIFA grants, cooperative agreements, endowments, and other financial assistance
- Updates and replaces former Administrative Manuals (identified below)





NIFA Policy Guide Development Timeline: NERAOC 2014 Status: Addressing Stakeholder comments

| Date | Goal |

| April 15, 2014 | Comment deadline for Policy Guide stakeholder review and comment. |
| May, 2014 | Policy Guide published in Federal Register for 45 day public comment period |
| June – Sept, 2014 | Final USDA and NIFA revisions and review |
| Oct. 1, 2014 | Final NIFA Policy Guide published and effective |
