How to make your
jars special!

There are many ways to make your jars pretty:

-
- Add labels; some from wood, some from card stock or adhesive labels. Add a recipe or a picture.
 - Add a fabric ruffle; over the top, under the band, with ribbon or without.
 - Add a fabric bonnet.
 - Tie a ribbon or rafia around the band.
 - Tie a ribbon or rafia around the jar from top to bottom.
 - Crochet a sleeve.





Supplies needed for a pretty jar ready to gift.

- Raffia or Jute
- Ribbon
- Lace Ribbon
- Fabric
- Elastic
- Labels – variety of mediums
- Flowers and glue

On the left: jars with a lace bonnet tied on with raffia or jute and a flower glued on, finished with a pretty personalized adhesive label. The right shows how to decorate a lid with a spiral of jute to create another type of décor. This can be accomplished after processing.
