WHAT IS MATCH.GRAZE

UC Cooperative Extension (UCCE)
Sonoma has created "Match.Graze", an online map connecting landowners who don't have grazing animals to livestock owners with animals that can provide vegetation management services through a tier system.



WHY GRAZE?

Grazing is an ecologically sound and effective way to reduce fine fire fuels, and in some situations, can be more cost-effective than alternative methods. Other vegetation tools include prescribed fire, mowing or herbicide treatments.



GRAZING TIERS

To determine your grazing need, UCCE has developed a 3-Tier grazing system:

Tier 1- Community Grazing

Tier 2- Contract/Targeted Grazing

Tier 3- Traditional/Land Lease Grazing

GRAZING ANIMALS

Different species of grazing animals, (cattle, sheep and goats), have different forage preferences. Deciding on the right species requires consideration of the type of terrain and vegetation you want to manage – this is something UCCE can help you figure out!
