QUALIFICATIONS:

Applicants must meet one of the following qualifications:

- 1. Be an immediate family member of a Plumas-Sierra County Farm Bureau voting member in good standing. Applicants may have any college major or be attending a trade school with any major.
- 2. Be a Plumas-Sierra County Farm Bureau Collegiate Member and a graduate or graduating from Plumas or Sierra County High School, majoring in an agricultural field at an accredited junior college, college, or trade school. You must be a collegiate member by the date of your submitted application.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- **Submit the completed application form** to the Plumas-Sierra County Farm Bureau Scholarship Committee by April 15th, 2024.
- Submit two letters of recommendation, each written within the past three months. LETTERS MUST BE SUBMITTED WITH THE APPLICATION. Must include: information about the applicant's character, ability, and how they will benefit from this scholarship and a college education.
- Official transcripts high school transcript (if currently attending HS) or current college transcripts. An official transcript MUST be submitted along with this application. The transcripts must be in a sealed envelope with the official seal. Computer generated copies are not acceptable.
- The application must have an **overall cumulative G.P.A. of 2.50**.
- Applicants must enroll or be enrolled as a full-time student (12 units) at a college/university, junior college, or trade school.
- Applicants must be willing to appear for a personal interview or have a telephone conference call with the Plumas-Sierra County Farm Bureau Scholarship Committee.

GENERAL INFORMATION & REGULATIONS

- 1. This scholarship is renewable. Past recipients are welcome and encouraged to apply. APPLICANTS MUST REAPPLY EACH YEAR. Only include current school transcript.
- 2. If a scholarship is awarded, the scholarship will be presented after the first semester if eligibility requirements are met. Eligibility is based upon completion of twelve units and a minimum of 2.50 G.P.A. Units and G.P.A. will be checked through an official transcript or report card upon the completion of the first semester and proof of enrollment for the second semester.
- 3. If a student drops out of school while the award is in effect, funds must be returned in full.
- **4.** All information submitted will be considered strictly confidential and used for the Plumas-Sierra County Farm Bureau Scholarship Committee for the selection of the scholarship recipients.

Scholarship is based on scholastic achievement, career goals, extra-curricular activities, leadership skills, written application and interview or conference call.
