THIRD YEAR

- 1. Apply 200 pounds of ammonium sulfate per acre following the first fall rain.
- 2. Graze in the same manner as suggested for second year.

FOURTH YEAR

- 1. Apply 200 pounds of ammonium sulfate and 300 pounds of single superphosphate per acre.
- 2. Graze in same manner as suggested for second year.

FOLLOWING YEARS

- 1. Every third or fourth year apply, in the fall, 300 pounds of single superphosphate per acre.
- 2. Apply 200 pounds of ammonium sulfate per acre each fall.
