Requirements to Sell Market Animals at Fair 2024

- **1.** Be an active member in the 4-H Online enrollment system by November 30, 2023.
- 2. Attend the required hours of market project meetings set by the leader for project completion.
- **3.** Attend county event or approved educational workshop specific to your market animal.
- **4.** Meet the ownership requirements for your market animal (see below).
- **5.** Submit an up-to-date Annual Project Report to your leader.
- **6.** Complete the Annual <u>YQCA</u> training (this is requirement set by the Fairs not 4-H).
- 7. Abide by the 4-H Member Code of Conduct.
- **8.** Abide by the rules of fairgrounds.
- 9. Download and read the Local Rules, Jr. Livestock Rules & Dress Code

- **10.** If selling at Shasta District Fair, deliver a completed, signed <u>4-H Fair Contract</u> to the 4-H office by the deadline of May 10, 2024.
- 11. If selling at the Inter-Mountain Fair, deliver a completed, signed Jr. Livestock Contract to the IM fairgrounds with your exhibit entries.

4-H Ownership Requirements

Market Steer - must be owned and supervised for not less than 120 consecutive days/ear tagged

Replacement Heifer - must be owned and supervised for not less than 120 consecutive days/ear tagged

Market Goat - must be owned and supervised for not less than 60 consecutive days/ear tagged

Poultry - must be owned and supervised for

not less than 30 consecutive days **and** be enrolled in the project for not less than 60 consecutive days.

Rabbits – must be owned and supervised for

not less than 30 consecutive days **and** be enrolled in the project for not less than 60 consecutive days.

Sheep - must be owned and supervised for not less than 60 consecutive days/ear tagged

Swine -must be owned and supervised for not less than 60 consecutive days/ear tagged
