A maximum of four 4-H members will be selected annually to be Shasta County 4-H Jr. Ambassadors. Members will be selected based on their outstanding project work, leadership, and community service.

The Jr. Ambassador Team assists the current Ambassador Team in carrying out their county leadership roles.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE Jr. AMBASSADOR TEAM

- 1. Work together as a team along with the Ambassadors to represent the Shasta County 4-H Program. The Jr. Ambassador Team will represent 4-H at civic and community affairs to share experiences and promote 4-H, as requested.
- 2. It is mandatory that each member of the Jr. Ambassador Team help with the annual Valley Achievement event. At this event you will receive recognition as a Jr. Ambassador Team member.
- 3. The Jr. Ambassador Team is highly encouraged to help with the Achievement Night for the Inter-Mountain 4-H program and any other Inter-Mountain 4-H event the member may be able to attend.
- **4.** The Jr. Ambassador Team will help the Ambassadors, as needed, at two (2) or more of the following countywide events: 4-H Achievement & Family Kick Off Day, Club Officer Training Day, Valley Livestock Judging Day, Junior and Teen Leadership Training Lock-in, Favorite Foods Day, Presentation Day, and Shasta County Field Day.
- 5. Assist the Ambassadors with Officer Installation, if requested to do so.
- 6. The Jr. Ambassador Team will:
 - o Hold meetings as needed to help promote the Shasta County 4-H Program.
 - Help at officer trainings, presentation trainings, or record book trainings when requested.
 - Maintain good communication with the Ambassadors.
- **7.** Attendance at that Shasta County Council Meetings, held on the third Wednesday of each month at the Shasta 4-H Office, is encouraged.

QUALIFICATIONS

All 4-H members who have met the following requirements are eligible to apply for the Jr. Ambassador Team:

- 1. In the 7th grade, or higher, during the current 4-H program year.
- 2. Are currently enrolled in the Shasta County 4-H program.
- 3. Have completed one or more program years of 4-H.

- 4. Have earned a Bronze Star rank or have written evidence of leadership experience skills.
- 5. Have completed one or more years as a Junior or Teen Leader.
- 6. Have submitted the Jr. Ambassador application to the Shasta County 4-H office by the deadline.
- 7. Complete the interview process. You will be notified of the interview date.
