



Agriculture and Natural Resources has rich and diverse facilities and natural resources encompassing over 12,000 acres of land. The main facilities of ANR are the ten Research and Extension Centers, located throughout the state. On these Centers and in other locations, there are over 500,000 square feet in buildings composed of offices, laboratories and facilities to support the extension and outreach efforts of ANR.

Facilities Planning and Management (FPM) provides professional management of all ANR construction projects, as well as overseeing the operation and maintenance of the facilities to the high standards established by the University of California.

FPM manages ANR's state-funded major capital improvement program as well as capital improvement projects funded by donors, grants and other sources.

- Over 250 buildings including laboratories, insectories, research barns, multipurpose facilities, greenhouses, lysimeters, weather stations, packing lines and other facilities.
