Weed Control Equipment Available!

Reserve the equipment by calling the El Dorado County Department of Agriculture at (530) 621-5520. A lease agreement must be completed at the time of pick up. A \$50.00 deposit is required to rent equipment, in addition to the daily or weekly rental fee as noted for each tool.

Rental Spray Equipment for Transline™ Herbicide Application

Boomless Sprayer

\$20.00 per day

This 20-gallon sprayer straps to an ATV or pickup tailgate and runs on a 12-volt motor. This sprayer has three built in nozzles and a hand wand. The side mounted nozzles spray an 8' swath for roadside spraying. The center nozzle can spray a 24' swath. A pistol type gun is also included which allows it to be used for spot spraying. This unit can be operated by remote from the cab of the truck.

ATV Sprayer/Pickup Mounted Boom Sprayer

\$20.00 per day

This 20-gallon sprayer straps onto an ATV or pickup truck. A 12-volt motor powers this sprayer, which has a hand wand for spot spraying and a 12' boom for strip spraying.

Cart Sprayer

\$20.00 per day

This 20-gallon cart sprayer can be towed behind an ATV or tractor. This sprayer has a hand wand only and is used for spot spraying or broadcast spraying for small infestations. A 12-volt motor powers the pump.

Backpack Sprayer

\$10.00 per day

The 4-gallon hand pressurized sprayer is used for spot applications or small area broadcast applications.

Spray equipment may only be used with Transline™ herbicide to prevent contamination of equipment due to improper cleaning. Use and purchase of Transline™ herbicide requires an operator identification number, which is obtained from the El Dorado County Department of Agriculture.

Weed Control Tools

Weed Wrenches

Free for two weeks - \$10/week after two weeks

Manually operated, all-steel tool designed to remove woody plants by uprooting. Position woody stem in gripping jaws and pull back on leverage handle to uproot stem. Works well on Scotch broom when the soil is moist. Three sizes available (small, medium or large); best size is determined by size of stems and operator.
