She planned the Fashion Revue for years and always crowned the winner. It is in her memory that this award was initiated. This award will be chosen based on the youth members' application and qualifications.

**ELIGIBILITY:**

Minimum qualifications - All 4-H members are eligible to apply for the Mary Lanzi Award if all of the following are true:

- ✓ be 9-19 yrs old by Dec. 31, 2022 (Junior, Intermediate, and Senior member) for the 2022-2023 4-H year
- ✓ be currently enrolled in the Glenn County 4-H Program;
- ✓ be currently enrolled in a Clothing & Textiles Project;
- ✓ have completed two or more years of 4-H;
