

# 4-H STEPS TO SUCCESS

### MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR ELIGIBILITY TO SHOW AND/OR SELL AN ANIMAL AT THE FAIR, AND REPRESENT NEVADA COUNTY 4-H AT STATE FAIR HORSE SHOWS

- ⇒ Must be enrolled in 4-H prior to attending any 4-H functions such as club meeting, project meeting, 4-H events.
- ⇒ Enroll in 4-H by county due date—All returning members and new members by January 1st, 2021. This change is for the 2020-21 4-H year only, by vote of the Council.
- Participate in a minimum of 80% of project instruction per project.
- Participate in one countywide activity or event, such as Achievement Night, Presentation Day, "You Make It Craft Expo" and Fun Fair.
- ⇒ Submit a 4-H Record Book. (Members 9 years or older) Record Book is due per each club's policy and by-laws
- ⇒ Attend 80% of the Community Club meetings.
  - If attendance falls below 80%, absences must be made up.
  - Have 60 days to complete make up and make ups completed before June 30.
  - Make up must be verified by paper signed and dated by adult in charge of meeting attended or materials submitted.

## If Unable to Attend 80% of the Meetings, You Can:

## Community Club Meetings

- ⇒ Attend and report back to your club:
  - \*A Council Meeting
  - \*Different club meeting
- ⇒ Video tape event and show to an audience and submit to county
- ⇒ Take pictures at county events and give to 4-H office
- ⇒ Assist in county event
- ⇒ Give a report on a project new to member at the club level
- ⇒ Write an article about county event that they have attended for the newspaper/newsletter
- ⇒ Individual project with prior approval of community leader
- ⇒ Other—upon prior approval of community leader

### Project

- ⇒ Demo in front of project group or classroom or different club's project meeting
- ⇒ Assigned research with prior approval of project leader
- ⇒ Assist in county event
- ⇒ Attend field day related to project
- ⇒ Other—upon prior approval of project leader
