

From I-5 South: Take Lathrop Road or Roth Road exit. Go east to S. Airport Way. Turn left (North) on S. Airport Way, and follow it to Arch-Airport Road. Turn right (East) and go to South B Street. Turn right, go one block to East Earhart Avenue.

From I-5 North: As you near the Port, follow the signs to exit at the right for Downtown Stockton/Fresno Ave./ Highway 4-East, then stay left to merge onto **4-East** to **99-South**. Then, follow the directions for **Highway 99** below.
