Flower	Achillea, Pearl Yarrow, Perennial	24-36", relative of common yarrow, lovely in bouquets, pom-pom small flowers, pollinator plant, perennial
Flower	Agastache, Arizona Sandstone, Perennial	8-10", hummingbird mint, compact Agastache, softly colored tubular dusty purple buds and markings on terracotta-orange blooms, tough drought tolerant, deer-resistant perennial
Flower	Agastache, Lavender Hyssop, Perennial	24-48", minty, anise-scented lavender-blue flowers, great pollinator, especially for native bees, good for tea and as a cut flower, deer-resistant perennial
Flower	Amaranthus, Love-Lies-Bleeding	36-48", crimson tassels cascade down bushy plan. Dramatic in the garden!
Flower	Ammi, Green Mist	36-48", fabulous flower for mixed bouquets, large, rounded umbels start out green turning white as the tiny flowers open. Known also as false Queen Anne's lace, attracts beneficials, wear gloves when harvesting, sap may irritate skin
Flower	Aster, Bengal Rose Frost	26-30", Botanical Interest anniversary aster, large decorative white dragon style, 4-5" bloom
Flower	Aster, Harlequin Light Rose	24-36", ballerina pink blossoms, fluffy, late summer/autumn bloom, 3" bloom, great cut flower
Flower	Aster, Harlequin Violet	24-36", giant textural flowers, waist high, rich grape-purple blooms, summer/autumn bloom, great cut flower
Flower	Aster, Moonstone	24-28", amazing color of smoky lavender with a muted metallic look, petals slightly incurved
Flower	Aster, Rose Quartz Mix	28-32", mix of warm pink tones: Dusty rose, blush and ballet slipper pink. Delicate ruffled blooms
Flower	Aster, Royal Purple Mix Tiger Paw	28-32", large quill-petaled flowers, frosted royal purple blooms, resemble sea anemones
Flower	Aster, Valkyrie Pink	24-36", mauve-pink, buds lighter than flowers, great color range. Long, pointed petals, cactus style flowers
Flower	Baby's Breath, Covent Garden	Lovely filler that produces clouds of small pure white flowers on each stem. Great cottage garden flower perfect in fresh or dried arrangements
Flower	Bells Of Ireland	24-36", green stalks of calyces with pure white tongues (corollas), great lime-green cut flower
Flower	Cleome, Color Fountains	48-60", vigorous summer flowers in pale pink, white and rose violet florets. Spidery stamens favorite of hummingbirds
Flower	Cosmos, Apricot Lemonade	20-30", starts soft apricot with dusty lavender reverse & fades to buttery yellow, pinwheel look. New!
Flower	Cosmos, Cupcake & Saucers Mix	48", favorite of MGs, winner of Nevada County Fair flower competition, double or semi double pinwheel of white, light pink & dark pink
Flower	Cosmos, Cupcake Blush	40-48", sugarplum fairy look, pale blush petals form teacup, large blooms

Flower	Didiscus, Madonna Blend, Hardy Annual	24-36", lavender blue, pink & white, tiny star-shaped flowers form lovely 2-3" heads, hardy annual to zone 7
Flower	Echinacea, Mellow Yellows, Perennial	32", blooms first year from seed, gold to yellow, primrose & cream mix, attracts pollinators, disease & pest resistant, perennial
Flower	Hyssop, True Hyssop, Perennial	12-24", ancient herb native to US prairies, heirloom, medicinal & culinary value, purple flower, deer-resistant perennial
Flower	Lavatera, Pink Regis	24-48", palm-sized hibiscus type pale-shell pink blooms with dark cranberry throats
Flower	Malope, Queen Pink	26-32", easy to grow, pretty hibiscus type flowers in magenta & pink. Shrub like, branched. A must have for the garden!

Flower	Monarda, Wild Bergamot, Perennial	36-48", cut flower and herb, a combination of oregano, thyme & mint, pollinator especially wood-nymph butterfly, deer-resistant perennial
Flower	Nicotiana, Flowering Tobacco Langsdorffii	24-36", delicate looking flowers, smaller than most flowering tobacco, looks like small ringing bells with pale green tint, great filler for bouquets, and hummingbirds love it!
Flower	Scabiosa, Black Knight, Hardy Annual	Pincushion flower, very dark burgundy flower head with white stigmas, 1st place winner at Nevada County Fair, deer-resistant pollinator plant, 1.5-2.5" blooms, hardy annual
Flower	Scabiosa, Isaac House Blend, Perennial	18-24", white, lilac & blue pincushion flowers, tough, drought tolerant plant, deer resistant, perennial
Flower	Scabiosa, Salmon Queen, Hardy Annual	36-40", beautiful salmon/pink hue, 1.5-2.5" bloom, deer resistant, hardy annual
Flower	Sunset Hibiscus	24-36", gorgeous hibiscus type flower, soft yellow with burgundy eye, great container plant
Flower	Tithonia, 'Fiesta Del Sol'	30", fast growing, 2 to 3" deep orange blossoms midsummer through fall. Profuse bloomer, attracts beneficials, AAS winner.
Flower	Zinnia, Amethyst Treasure Hybrid	12-18", compact, well branched double flowering purple 3-4" bloom
Flower	Zinnia, Benary Giant Lilac	36-48", starts vivid lilac, outer petals fade to pale lavender, mostly double 4-5" bloom, high yields, great disease resistance
Flower	Zinnia, Benary Giant Wine	32", deep wine hue, extra large 4-5" bloom, high yields, cut & come again type zinnia
Flower	Zinnia, Bling Bling	36-42", custom blend of rich orange, yellow and violet/purple. Tall, multi-branching florist quality double blooms

Herb	Basil, Cardinal	Tightly packed, cardinal red blooms are a striking addition to any herb garden. Strong, deep burgundy stems hold fragrant, tasty, bright green leaves. Vibrant and colorful throughout the summer. Also great for pesto. Height 24-30"
Herb	Basil, Large Leaf Italian	Large plant, 18-24" tall, 12-15" wide with medium-dark green leaves up to 3" long. Sweeter pesto type with high yields. Pinch back constantly (harvesting the leaves) to keep bushier with more production. Full sun, moist, rich soil. (Genovese)
Herb	Basil, Lime	Heirloom. Lime flavor mixed with basil flavor. 2" green leaves. Use for chicken, fish, salads, ice tea. Substitute for lemongrass in Asian recipes. 12-20" tall.
Herb	Basil, Mrs. Burns Lemon	Open pollinated, sweet and tangy lemon basil, flavor is intense basil and citrus. Bright green, 2 1/2" leaves with white blooms make this basil attractive and intensely flavorful. Edible flowers. Ht. 20-24".
Herb	Basil, Thai Siam Queen	Thai basil is a key ingredient in Asian cuisine (including Thai red and green curry), offering a sweet, anise, clove flavor. Green leaves on purple stems with purple flowers. Grows well in containers. 12"-24" tall.
Herb	Catnip	Great cat-attracting perennial with gray-green leaves and white flowers. Used for cat toys or herbal teas. In addition to attracting your cat, flowers are attractive to bees. Container growing is recommended to prevent unwanted spread of this vigorous plant.
Herb	Parsley, Italian Flat Leaf	Italian heirloom. Hardy biennial likes full sun or partial shade. Exceptionally large, flat glossy leaves with a sweet and mellow flavor. Height 12-18".
Vegetable	Cucumber, Lemon	Unusual cuke is bright lemon yellow, round, and best when harvested at 2" across for either pickles or salads. Flavor is sweet, mild, never bitter, with an old-fashioned cucumber flavor with a hint of nuttiness. Heirloom
Vegetable	Cucumber, Marketmore Select	Popular variety is a consistent producer of delicious, mildly sweet cucumbers with dark green protective skin. Highly disease-resistant and produce over a long season in hot or cool weather. A selection from marketmore 76.
Vegetable	Cucumber, National Pickling	This is the pickling cuke that pickle growers asked for. High yielding, early fruiting on vigorous, medium vines. Retains quality over a long season. Dark green fruit can be picked small at 2"-3" long for gherkins or larger at 5"-6" long for full sized pickles
Vegetable	Cucumber, Richmond Green Apple	Unique heirloom from Australia. Fruits are the size of a lemon but are a beautiful light green color. Very mild, sweet and juicy. Hard to find and fun to grow.
Vegetable	Cucumber, Spacemaster 80	Compact cucumber ideal for containers. Short hardy vines produce slender, dark green fruits 7.5" long. Prolific and great in salads or plain. Height 6-8"; spread 26".
Vegetable	Cucumber, Striped Armenian	Heirloom. Introduced from Armenia to Italy in the 1400's. This unusual and attractive 12"-18" cucumber is always sweet and crispy, even when fruit is large. Thin-skinned, green with ridges has a dense flesh, few seeds, and a pleasant, mild flavor. Also known as the painted serpent. Handle carefully to avoid bruising. Closely related to melons.

Vegetable	Eggplant, Black Beauty	Popular heirloom variety. Glossy fruits become quite large, but are well shaped and perfect for thick slices for grilling. Harvest when fruit is shiny and before skin becomes dull. Harvest at about 6" long.
Vegetable	Eggplant, Orient Express	Outstanding early productivity. Attractive, slender, 8-10", glossy black fruits in the long Oriental style. Sets fruit in cool weather as well as under heat stress. Tender, delicately flavored, and quick cooking. Purple calyx.
Vegetable	Eggplant, Purple Long	Prolific Italian variety. Heavily branched plants typically yield 4 or more dark-purple, cucumber-shaped fruit 8"-10" long.
Vegetable	Greens, Amaranth, Chinese Multicolored Spinach	Chinese Multicolor spinach isn't actually a spinach at all. It's an amaranth. The lime-green colored foliage, splashed with magenta, makes a riot of color in the garden and on the plate. In Asia, it's popular as a leafy green, eaten in high summer.
Vegetable	Greens, Arugula, Rocket, Common	21 days baby; 40 days full size. The standard salad arugula thrives in cool weather. Delicious salad green has a spicy flavor when mature. Long, dark green, lobed leaves are suitable for salads or bunching. White flowers with dark pink veins make attractive spicy additions to salad mixes. <i>Eruca sativa</i>
Vegetable	Greens, Kale, Lacinato	Italian heirloom. Lacinato or "dinosaur" type. Unique leaf type noncurled but heavily blistered (savoyed). Rich, tender leaves have a softer texture than curly green kales. Tolerant of hot and cold weather. <i>Brassica oleracea</i> .
Vegetable	Greens, Shiso/Perilla, Green & Red Mix	Spicy Oriental favorite. Distinct cinnamon/clove flavor and aroma, with the spiciness of cumin. Bright emerald leaves are slightly spicier than the red variety. 18-30" tall. (self-sows)spicy oriental favorite. Distinct cinnamon/clove flavor and aroma, with the spiciness of cumin. Leaves are dark purplish-red. red shiso colors radish pickles and "umeboshi" plums. 18-30" tall. (self-sows)
Vegetable	Greens, Swiss Chard, Perpetual Spinach	50 days. Belongs to the same species as chard and beets, but it has distinctive differences. The taste is more like a true spinach than ordinary chard, and the leaves look like spinach too—flatter and more pointed than chard, with slimmer stems.
Vegetable	Melon, Ambrosia	A top selling cantaloupe. Luscious, extra-sweet, and juicy with a delectable aroma. 6" melons average 5 lbs. Each. Vines are resistant to powdery mildew and yield bumper crops.
Vegetable	Melon, Athena	About 60 days. Hybrid. An early-maturing cantaloupe renowned for its firm, aromatic, absolutely delicious flesh, Athena has great holding power on the vine. This is a melon you don't have to rush to harvest, and every 5- to 6-pound fruit is super sweet, succulent, and delicious!
Vegetable	Melon, Lilliput	80 days from setting out transplants. No more wasted cantaloupe slices with Lilliput! This personal-sized melon is just right for one person to devour at a single sitting. And because it grows quickly, finishes fast, and smells as good as it tastes, you will most likely gobble up the entire generous harvest in no time, and put Lilliput at the top of your list for next year's veggie garden!
Vegetable	Melon, Sarah's Choice	Cantaloupe type. Sweet and juicy flesh has been a winner in trials. Attractive oval 3 lb. fruits. Disease resistant

Vegetable	Pepper, Anaheim	80 days. An old favorite with unparalleled taste, Anaheim TMR has been the choice of gardeners for generations! Relatively mild, these peppers measure 8 inches long and 2 1/2 inches wide. They arise on sturdy 28- to 34-inch plants, which offer great foliage protection for the growing fruit. 1 out of 5 on heat scale.
Vegetable	Pepper, Big Daddy	These huge 8-10" sweet Marconi peppers are glossy golden yellow, thick-walled and crispy sweet. They are great tasting grilled, sautéed, stir-fried, roasted, or stuffed. Big Daddy produces jumbo, 10-in. (25-cm) yellow peppers in three months. Pick a sunny location that you can water every couple days and keep a couple stakes handy in case the stalks begin to bend.
Vegetable	Pepper, Caballero	95 days from setting out transplants. Caballero is the bestselling poblano pepper in the world, and one crop will show you why. For huge yields of large, glossy, uniform, deliciously mild peppers, rely on this trusted favorite! Up to 6 inches long and 3 inches wide (at the shoulder), this thick-walled pepper is perfect for stuffing, and is the classic chile relleno ingredient.
Vegetable	Pepper, Cal Wonder	Large, blocky, thick-walled peppers with 3-4 large lobes perfect for stuffing. Glossy, deep-green peppers turn red at maturity. Large upright plants are prolific producers. Heirloom.
Vegetable	Pepper, Carmen	Sweet peppers in the Italian bull's horn style mature at least a week earlier than comparative types. Beautiful fruits have the traditional horn shape and grow to 6 in. Long and 2-1/2 in. Wide, with wide shoulder tapering to a point. (2006 AAS winner)
Vegetable	Pepper, Corno Di Toro	75 days from transplanting. This delicious heirloom Italian sweet frying pepper is named "bull's horn" for its distinctive twisted shape! The huge 8-inch fruits mature from glossy green to dark red, with a flavor that combines sweetness with a rich tangy bite. Try it this season and we predict that you will make it part of your permanent pepper patch!
Vegetable	Pepper, Fresno	This mildly hot pepper is a very heavy producer, with consistently glossy, high-quality, 2" by 1" fruit, on 24-30" plants. It needs little water during the growth season compared with many others, and you can tailor its heat level by picking it green for mildest flavor, deep red for hottest, and orange for a happy medium. Not suitable for drying into spice but ideal for eating fresh, stuffing, canning, pickling, frying, and sautéing. 2 out of 5 on heat scale
Vegetable	Pepper, Friariello	These sweet and flavorful frying peppers make such a warming, comforting dish from southern Italy. Tall, bush plants make tons of green fruits that ripen to bright red. Fry these green sweet, flavorful peppers (whole or chopped) in olive oil with garlic and salt; add cut up tomatoes and then fresh basil and parmesan cheese. That's it! Enjoy! Mangia!
Vegetable	Pepper, Golden Treasure	80 days. A rare old Italian heirloom saved by our friends at Seed Savers Exchange! Unbeatable for frying, roasting or eating fresh. Nine-inch long fruits ripen from green to shiny golden-yellow. Not unlike our Marconi types, with very sweet, medium-thick flesh and tender skin.
Vegetable	Pepper, Habanero	Extraordinary heat combined with fruity, citrus notes. Avg. 2" x 1 1/4", wrinkled fruits ripen from dark green to salmon orange. This extremely pungent habanero may be used fresh or dried. Key ingredient in Jamaican "jerk" sauces. 5 out of 5 on heat scale.
Vegetable	Pepper, Jalapeno, Early	Ideal for Mexican dishes. Deep green fruits mature to red. Sausage-shaped fruits, 3-1/2" by 1-1/2", are also perfect for pickling. Matures earlier than regular jalapeno. Compact bushes. 3 out of 5 heat scale.
