



These 8 to 12 oz. globe-shaped fruit grow on highly disease-resistant plants, having no cracking, and offer great, old-fashioned flavor. 





This new variety has a firmer skin and acid and sugar balance reminiscent of the original Rutgers tomato.





BLACK BEAUTY

Slicing - World's Darkest Tomato- A dark, meaty, very rich-fleshed tomato with extreme anthocyanin expression (same antioxidant in blueberries and blackberries). So dark that some tomatoes turn solid blue-black on the skin. Deep red flesh is among the best tasting of all tomatoes. Rich, smooth and savory with earthy tones. Hangs well on the vine and stores very well, and the flavor improves with room-temperature storage. Plants need to be staked or caged.





<p>BLACK KRIM</p>  <p>Rare Seeds</p>	<p><i>Beefsteak</i> - Russian Heirloom. Black Krim combines bold, smoky flavor and good texture with an unusual appearance. Deep brown/red, 8-16 oz. tomatoes have brown/green shoulders that get darker with more heat and sunlight. High yielding.</p> <p>Plants need to be staked or caged.</p>			
<p>CHEROKEE PURPLE</p>  <p>Johnny Seeds</p>	<p><i>Beefsteak</i> - Unusual variety with full flavor. Famously rich flavor and texture make this a colorful favorite among heirloom enthusiasts. Medium-large, flattened globe, 8-12 oz. fruits. Color is dusky pink with dark shoulders. Multilocular interior ranges from purple to brown to green. Relatively short vines.</p> <p>Plants need to be staked or caged.</p>			
<p>CHOCOLATE STRIPES</p>  <p>David's Garden Seeds</p>	<p><i>Slicing</i> - A beautiful true show stopper, Chocolate Stripes Tomatoes feature mahogany colored flesh with olive green striping. Complex, rich, earthy flavors reward the gardener with plants that yield a plentiful crop of 3" to 6" fruit.</p> <p>An excellent choice for salads and sandwiches, this one just might become your favorite! Plants need to be staked or caged.</p>			
<p>GREEN ZEBRA</p>  <p>David's Garden Seeds</p>	<p><i>Slicing</i> - Uniquely green with gold-striped salad specialty. A delicious, tangy salad tomato, ripe just as the green fruit develops a yellow blush, accentuating the darker green stripes. The 3 to 4 ounce fruits are the ideal size for slicing into wedges for salads. 

GARDEN HINTS: Fertilize when first fruits form to increase yield. Water deeply once a week during very dry weather. Plants need to be staked or caged.




Rare Seeds
