<b>Ball's Beefsteak</b>  Tomato Grower Seeds	<p><i>Beefsteak</i> - This is a great choice for gardeners who want to grow luscious big tomatoes but need them to mature early and stand up to the challenges of disease problems. These 8 to 12 oz. globe-shaped fruit grow on highly disease-resistant plants, having no cracking, and offer great, old-fashioned flavor. <b>Better Boy</b>  Burpee Seeds	<p><i>Beefsteak</i> - Huge, tasty, red tomatoes, many weighing 1 lb. each. High yielding fruits are borne in abundance starting midseason and continuing to frost.
