

Dear Friends of Elkus Ranch,



UC Davis Livestock Herd Health team visits Elkus Ranch

Dr. Joan Rowe and her team of resident veterinarians, Dr. Celeste Morris and Dr. Muzafar Makhdoomi, from UC Davis conducted a biosecurity workshop and animal assessment at Elkus Ranch. The team evaluated our livestock herd health, provided insights and recommendations for nutrition and management based on our specific environment, and performed ultrasounds on our goat herd (pictured below).

Dr. Martin Smith (UCCE Specialist) led activities and was instrumental in the development of our current biosecurity protocols. As a result of this training, we have incorporated improved biosecurity practices into ranch maintenance and programming.

Talking Trash Waste Reduction

This year we implemented a new waste reduction awareness and understanding curriculum into our ranch field trip program, including new educational displays and opportunities for youth to actively sort their food waste at the end of their field trip.

The goal is to increase students' knowledge, awareness and sense of efficacy to reduce waste by using the 4 Rs: Reduce, Reuse, Recycle, and Rot.
