Entries will be accepted from 9:00 a.m.-10:00 a.m.; judging will begin at 10:15 a.m. Awards will be presented. Then we will eat the goodies!

Guidelines:

- 1. A total of 4 entries may be entered, one in each of the categories
- 2. Pre-entry is NOT required
- 3. All entries must be made by the member
- 4. Complete recipes must be included; printed or typed, including the category and division
- 5. Mini members will receive participation ribbons only.
- 6. All 4-H members are eligible and encouraged to participate.

Categories & Divisions

<u>Category 1–Dairy Foods</u>- one of the principal ingredients must be a dairy product such as butter, milk, cheese, sour cream, yogurt, etc. No substitutes. Acceptable entries include: Appetizers/cheese balls, cookies, cakes, desserts, breads.

<u>Category 2- Candies</u>-Caramels/taffies, chew candies, cream, fudges, divinity dipped candies, fruit and nut candies, **OR**

brittles, candied apples, stuffed dates, hard candies, lollipops, lemon drops, gum drops, popcorn balls, etc

<u>Category 3- Healthier Goodies</u>- One or more of the principal ingredients must be nutritious, i.e. whole wheat grains, bran, nuts, fruits, and carob. Acceptable entries include: Appetizers and snacks, cookies, breads, desserts, cakes.

<u>Category 4-Made From a Mix</u>-Ingredients must be made with a prepared food and/or mix, but NOT made solely from a mix or "place and baked" product. Must include additional ingredients, NOT just items listed in mix instructions. Acceptable entries include: Appetizers and snacks (no meat items), cookies, breads, desserts, cakes.

Age Divisions

Mini Members

Junior: 4th & 5th Grade

Intermediate: 6th to 8th Grade

Senior: 9th Grade and above

<u>Reminder</u>- COMPLETE recipes (ingredients and instructions) are required for all categories.

Incomplete recipes will not be eligible for awards. Any item which poses a food safety risk will not be judged.
