## 4-H Members: Help Law Enforcement Help You

As fair time is coming, preparation has begun. Sonoma County Farm Bureau, 4-H Foundation of Sonoma County and the Sheriff's Office Rural Crime Task Force want to help with your preparation needs and protect your fair equipment.

The Sheriff's Office implemented an Owner Applied Number (OAN) Program to help law enforcement identify stolen property; returning property to the rightful owners and assistance with stolen property investigations. This program has proven to be very successful.

Once an individual receives his or her OAN number, the Sheriff's Office Rural Crime Task Force can stamp (mark) the number onto various types of items: tackle boxes and equipment, saddles, trailers, tools, etc. On May 31st, the Sheriff's Office will be marking fair equipment and trailers. Registration for time slots will need to be made.

The process is easy:
