TYPE AND SIZE	True to type for the variety or group. Conforms to market size.	20 points
UNIFORMITY	Specimens uniform in size, color, shape type and maturity.	20 points
CONDITION	Well grown, good color and shape, clean trimmed, free from blemishes and rot.	20 points
MARKET QUALITY	Prime edible maturity, firm, tender, crisp and fresh.	20 points
