Score Card for Judging Fruit and Vegetable Plate

ARRANGEMENT	20 points
Properly displayed, neat, correct number of specimens, labeled properly, and has educational value.	
TYPE AND SIZE	20 points
True to type for the variety or group. Conforms to market size.	
UNIFORMITY	20 points
Specimens uniform in size, color, shape type and maturity.	
CONDITION	20 points
Well grown, good color and shape, clean trimmed, free from blemishes and rot.	
MARKET QUALITY	20 points
Prime edible maturity, firm, tender, crisp and fresh.
