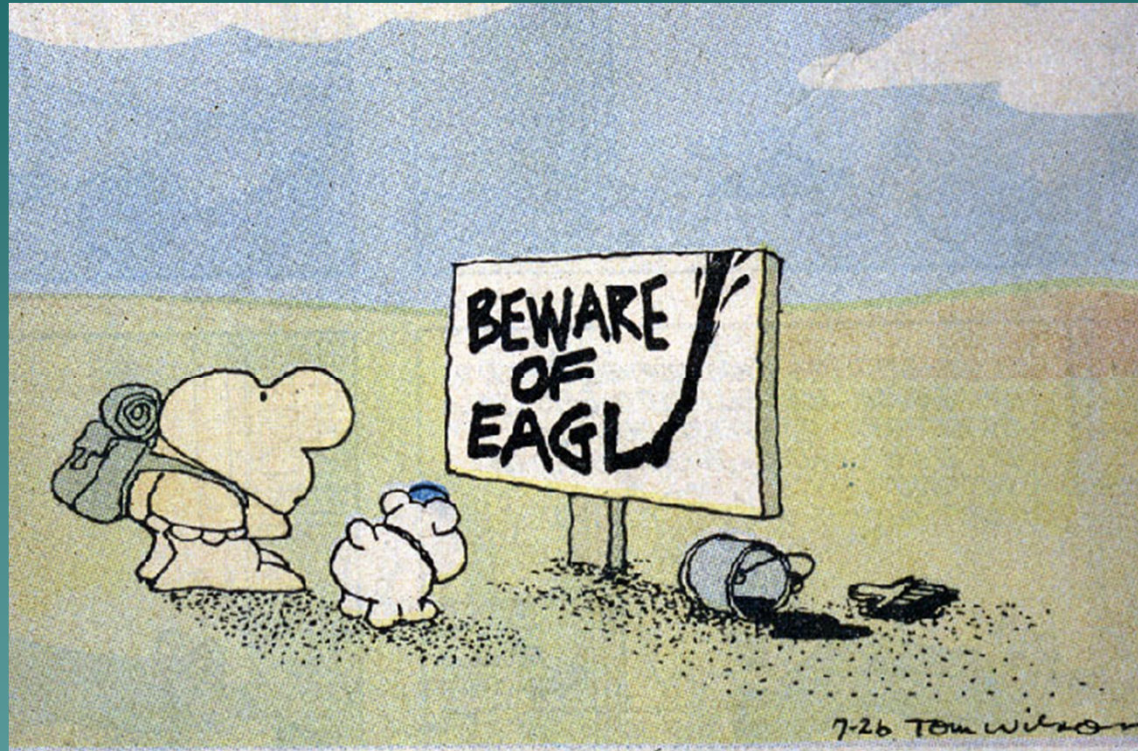


Bird Damage Management

CALIFORNIA LAW

CALIFORNIA FISH AND GAME CODE

Provisions within State Fish & Game code for...

- ◆ Crop depredation
- ◆ Public health problems (roosts)
- ◆ Other situations of economic loss and risk when caused by protected species

Protection can apply to...

- ◆ Nests
- ◆ Eggs
- ◆ Nestlings
- ◆ Non-lethal efforts to control damage or nuisance aspects (harassment /frightening efforts)

When making birds damage
control recommendations...

it's better to err on the side
of caution!

(ask a regulatory authority
first!)

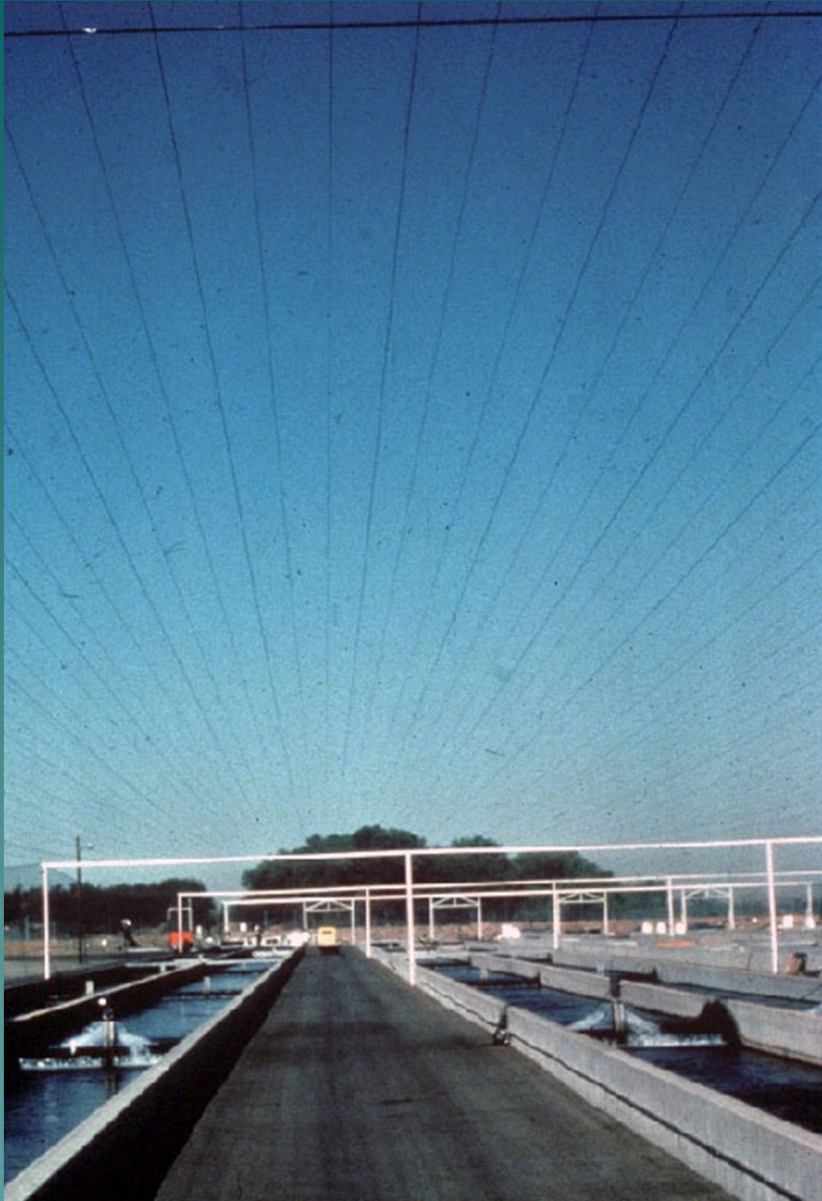

- ◆ Wires



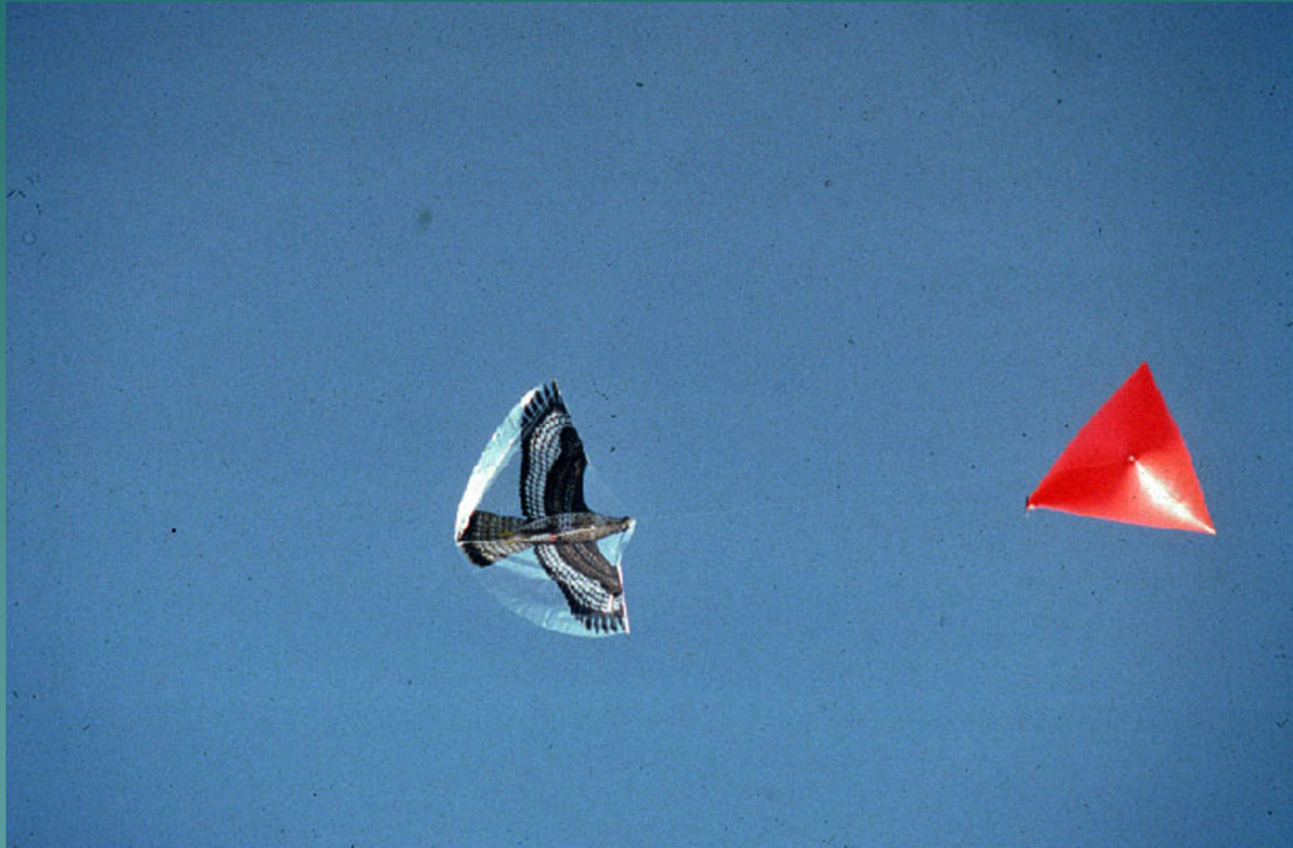




Wires:
