**LOCATION:** Redwood Empire Fairgrounds, Ukiah, California

**TIME:** Purebred Breeding Sheep Show will begin promptly at 10:00am

**HEALTH CHECK:** See schedule

**CHECK-IN:** See schedule, health check must be completed first.

**BREEDING SHOW** – Breeding sheep entries and fees must be received by May 19, 2011

Unlimited entries, two head per class paid. Late entries will not be used to determine class breakdowns.

**“BRED & OWNED IN MENDOCINO COUNTY” MARKET LAMB SHOW** – 100 pound maximum weight limit. Limit two (2) head per exhibitor. These lambs may also show in the regular market lamb classes, *however an entry fee is required for both class.*

**MARKET SHOW** – No weight limit. Lambs must have lambs teeth to qualify for the market lamb classes. Limit two (2) head per exhibitor. All breeds show together. Class divisions by weight will be determined on show day.

**ALL BREED UNREGISTERED YEARLING EWE AND EWE LAMB CLASSES** Limit two head per exhibitor per class.

**Jr. & Sr. SHOWMANSHIP** – Help us to plan by registering early. All exhibitors are eligible for showmanship. **Age breakdown is: 8 and under, 9-12, 13-15, 16 and over as of show day.**

**BARBEQUE** – Hamburgers, cheeseburgers, hot dogs, chips, cookies and sodas (meal or a la carte). See menu on our website ([www.socosheep.com](http://www.socosheep.com)).

**Rainbow Ag will be Selling Sheep Supplies!**

- Eligibility: Participants must be residents of: Marin, Sonoma, Napa, Mendocino, Lake, Humboldt, or Del Norte Counties. **NO MINIMUM AGE LIMIT for exhibitors. MAX. AGE LIMIT: Breeding – 1 year after graduating from high school or equivalent. Market – High School senior or equivalent.**
- Exhibitors may show from their trailers, but health checks will be required for all animals exhibiting.
- If pens are used, **EXHIBITOR MUST CLEAN PENS; NO STRAW OR SHAVINGS WILL BE PROVIDED** (Bring your own).
- **ANY ANIMAL COMING INTO THE SHOW HAVING CONTAGIOUS OR INFECTIOUS DISEASES SUCH AS “PINK-EYE”, SORE MOUTH, OR CLUB LAMB FUNGUS WILL BE DISQUALIFIED! ALL ANIMALS IN SAME TRAILER MAY ALSO BE DISQUALIFIED!**
- Ewes entered in Unregistered Ewe classes cannot be shown in any other class.
- Entry forms and fees must be **received** by May 19 2011, or late fees will apply.
- Scrapie tags are required on all livestock being exhibited.
- **Premiums will be paid at the conclusion of the show. You must be present to receive your premium. If you leave early, you forfeit your premium. Premiums will only be given to exhibitors.**

## 2011 North Coast Invitational Junior Sheep Show Health Check Information

The NCI staff are concerned about maintaining the health of you and your livestock. **All sheep will be required to have a Health Check document issued by an NCI staff member prior to being unloaded for penning or show at the 2011 NCI show.** Please follow the instructions below when arriving at the NCI show on May 22, 2011.

- After parking, proceed to the table marked “NCI Health Check” and wait for the next available NCI staff person.
- Proceed with your “Health Check Document” to the registration table to check-in and/or pay fees. **Registration paperwork will not be processed and animals may not go over the scales unless this paperwork is provided first.**

9:00am – 10:00am: Health Check and Registration for Breeding Sheep  
(market animals may be checked during this time)

10:00am – 11:00am: Health Check for market animals

11:00am – 12:00pm: Market Lamb weigh-in

\*\*\*\*\* **Note** \*\*\*\*\*

**\*\*All lambs showing slick-shorn must arrive shorn. No shearing of lambs will be permitted at the show in order that a Health Check can be properly performed.**

**\*\*If a transmissible disease or condition is found on any animal in a trailer or pen, all the animals arriving with it will be excused from the show. Please check your animals at home for transmissible conditions.**
