BE ALERT!

This field meeting is designed to help growers and their workers learn to identify major grape pests and their natural enemies.

Mealybugs (Grape mealybug, Gill's mealybug, and Vine mealybug) and the European Grapevine Moth (EGVM), *Lobesia botrana*, will be covered.

With Special Guest Dr. Lucia Varela, North Coast UC IPM Advisor

Lucia is an expert on grape pest identification and control and has worked in Sonoma/Napa on a wide range of grape problems, including EGVM. EGVM is a new pest in California that has spread in the Coastal areas. Know what to look for to identify this new pest threat! Lucia will train workers on how to look for pest clues in the vineyard.

Lynn Wunderlich will cover Grape and Gill's mealybug ID (both present in the foothills) and her insecticide trial results for managing mealybugs.
