Livestock Office

- I. Announcements from Theresa
 - a. Emergency Plan-in the event of an emergency that requires evacuation, use the following evacuation plans:
 - i. East of Grand Stands-evacuate to the East
 1. Exit through gates 5 & 6
 2. Split up clubs in alphabetical order
 3. Count members once they are in line
 4. Groups will be escorted out the gates once the all clear has been given
 - ii. Carnival Exit-patrons and workers will exit through the south gate.
 - b. Consumer Protection Plan-
 - i. This plan was mandated by the insurance carrier
 - ii. We need to be vigilant about our members
 1. Make sure they wash their hands
 2. Made sure they do not bring food into the animal areas
 - iii. No food is allowed in the barn-there are designated areas for eating
 - iv. Sperber Arena will be closed to animals after the first weekend of the fair
 1. There will be special instructions on how to bring food in for potlucks
 - v. The area behind the auction ring is designated for food on the day of the auction
 1. Wash racks will be closed on auction day at 8am
 2. Wash racks are open on Friday night without any restrictions
 - vi. Small Animal and Sheep Barns
 1. Sheep Barn-
 - a. West side door=exit only for humans, not for animals
 - b. North and South Doors=open for ventilation only, not for traffic
 - c. East Door=exit for animals only
 2. Small Animals-
 - a. Exit out of the east of the barn
 - b. Go around the 4-H Lamb Barn
 - c. Waste Disposal
 - i. 1 disposal site near the Goat Barn
 - ii. Water cannot be thrown into gardens; a designated container must be used for disposal of water
 - iii. Hours will be posted for the disposal area; an alternate site will be available for off hours

- d. Policy for Noncompliance-
 - i. This policy is meant for repeat offenders
 - ii. 3 strike policy
 - 1. On the 3rd warning:
 - a. Animal of member will be disqualified
 - b. Public will be escorted out
 - c. Staff will be fired
- e. RV passes will be available next weekend
- f. Exhibitors passes
 - i. Form is due on Monday to the fair office (for 4-H and FFA)
- g. Drug withdrawal form will reflect the new Consumer Protection
- h. Stall cards and traveling papers will be available in livestock office this week.
