4-H – Events

General Description: **The potential risk to 4-H youth at 4-H events (see also Risk: 4-H Youth Injury Prevention & Safety and Risk: Food Safety & Alcohol)**

- A. Food poisoning at UCCE/4-H events.
- B. Having 4-H club members clean up and serve at wine-related events.
- C. Inadequate safety precautions/guidelines at 4-H events.
- D. Inadequate training for volunteers/staff on safety practices/procedures.
- E. Little, if no, risk assessment of risk involved in 4-H events.
- F. Not having medically trained staff at large/overnight events.
