Food Safety and Alcohol

General Description: **The risk associated with serving food and alcohol at University-sponsored events.**

Specific Examples:

- A. Risks at UCCE events, including fund raisers, due to untrained staff or volunteers preparing and serving meals and food being served as a complimentary item.

- B. The use of alcohol at UCCE events, including UCCE staff or advisors attending wine-tasting events, and DUIs associated with fund-raising events.

- C. Alcohol and Drugs at 4-H Events (see also Risk: Safety in Program Delivery)
 - 1. Older 4-H kids enticing younger ones to try drugs.
 - 2. Youth exposed to alcohol, drugs, etc., under UCCE supervision.
 - 3. Risk of person(s) getting injured at events such as the Junior Livestock Auction at County Fair because alcohol is promoted to “loosen up” buyers.
 - 4. Having 4-H club members clean up and serve at wine-related events.
