

ANR Cooperative Extension Risk Assessment Risk Categories

Property

General Description: **Category encompasses all risks and liabilities associated with property. Includes damage/loss of UC or cooperator's property. Also includes the liabilities associated with the use of property, in particular non-UC property, to conduct research and deliver programs.**

Specific Examples:

- A. UC Property (land, buildings, equipment, etc.)
 - 1. The risk of personal (physical) injury sustained by the public while on UC property.
 - 2. Loss or damage to UC property by visitors/public.

- B. Non - UC property
 - 1. The risk of causing damage to a cooperator's property.
 - 2. The risk of lawsuits from attendees getting hurt during a ranch/field tour, held by an advisor on private property.
 - 3. Loss of property used or stored at home.
 - 4. Claims for compensation by a cooperator for crop losses resulting from research activities.
 - 5. The risk of personal (physical) injury sustained by the public while on County property.
