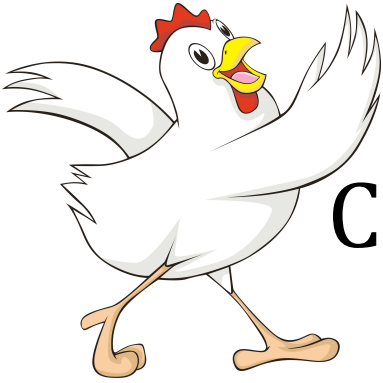


The SRJC Poultry Enterprise Project and the Chicken Chat Coop
