<p>Arctostaphylos ‘Emerald Carpet’</p>		<p>Carpet Manzanita</p>
		<p>This low growing evergreen groundcover will grow 12-18” tall and 3-6’ wide. It has dark, glossy green leaves, attractive cinnamon red bark, and sparse white flowers in late winter through early spring which are followed by red berries. It is a nice, tidy groundcover suitable for a non-walkable lawn alternative. Full sun to part shade.</p>
<p>Astericus maritimus ‘Compact Gold Coin’</p>		<p>Mediterranean Beach Daisy</p>
		<p>This prostrate evergreen groundcover will grow 6-12” tall and 3-4’ wide. It has green to gray-green leaves, and yellow-gold, daisy like flowers in summer, with some flowers present almost year around. This groundcover responds well to shearing to improve appearance and promote blooming. This plant does best in well-draining soil. Full sun to part sun.</p>
<p>Calycanthus occidentalis</p>		<p>Western Spice Bush</p>
		<p>This large deciduous shrub reaches 8-10’ tall and wide. It has glossy, aromatic, leathery, dark-green foliage and dark red flowers spring into summer. While this shrub is native to moist, shady stream banks of the Sierra Nevada foothills, it can tolerate less water if planted in more shade. It can develop leaf burn if soil is too dry. Good for erosion control. Full sun to shade.</p>
<p>Ceanothus griseus horizontalis ‘Yankee Point’</p>		<p>Yankee Point Ceanothus</p>
		<p>Evergreen durable ground cover grows to 2-3’ tall and 6’ plus in width. It has large green, glossy leaves and arching branches with clear blue flowers in early spring. Good for erosion control. Full sun to part shade.</p>
<p>Cercis occidentalis</p>		<p>Western Redbud</p>
		<p>This small deciduous multi-trunked, small tree or large shrub can reach 20’ tall and wide. Showy clusters of violet pink flowers occur in early spring before medium heart-shaped green leaves emerge. It develops long seedpods that remain on the tree into winter. This plant does best in well-drained soil. Full sun.</p>



CA Native Little to DT Low to Moderate Regular Water Deer Tolerant Habitat Small Garden Friendly

<p>Dymondia margaretae</p> 	  	<p>Silver Carpet</p> <p>This evergreen ground-hugging perennial grows 1-3" tall and up to 2' wide. It has silver foliage and small yellow daisy-like flowers in summer. It can be used between stepping stones, or as a lawn substitute where it can withstand light foot traffic. Full sun to part shade.</p>
<p>Epilobium septentrionale 'Select Mattole'</p> 	  	<p>Select Mattole California Fuchsia</p> <p>This sprawling winter dormant perennial/subshrub grows to about 1' tall and 2-3' wide. It has silver leaves and bright red to red/orange flowers summer into fall, which attract hummingbirds. Established plants benefit from being cut back in late fall/winter. California fuchsias have brittle stems, so they should be planted away from high traffic areas. Full sun to part sun.</p>
<p>Frangula (Rhamnus) californica 'Mound San Bruno'</p> 	  	<p>Mound San Bruno Coffeeberry</p> <p>This slow growing evergreen shrub grows to 4-6' tall and 6-8' wide. It is a dense shrub with dark green leaves and has inconspicuous white flowers which become berries that turn from green to bright red to black as they mature. Birds are attracted to the fruit. Full sun to part shade.</p>
<p>Lagerstroemia 'Natchez'</p> 		<p>Natchez Crape Myrtle</p> <p>This medium-sized deciduous tree grows to about 20' tall and wide. It has smooth, cinnamon-brown exfoliating bark, with a multitude of white flowers in summer. The leaves turn orange-red in fall. Excellent specimen tree in a low water landscape. The hybrid series has been bred for disease resistance. Flower color, fall color and size vary. Examples include 'Hopi' (8' tall, pink), 'Miami' (16' tall, dark pink), 'Arapaho' (20' tall, red), etc. Full sun.</p>
<p>Salvia greggii cultivars</p> 		<p>Autumn Sage</p> <p>Evergreen open airy shrub that can reach up to 2-4 feet tall and up to 4 feet wide depending on the cultivar. Many small colorful flowers appear spring to fall, and intermittently throughout the year. Various cultivars produce flowers in whites, yellows, pinks, purples, salmons, and reds. Highly attractive to hummingbirds and bees. Full sun.</p>
