- Make A Plan
- Practice & Time Evacuation Plan
- Prepare A Mobile Pet/Animal Disaster Kit
- Prepare Copies of Animal Ownership & Medical Records
- Identify Emergency Numbers/Contacts
- Keep Vaccinations Current
- Licensing, I.D. & Micro-Chipping Information Current

Emergency Supply Checklist:

- Crate/Carriers
- Leash/Harness
- Collar/I.D. tags
- Collapsible water dishes/buckets
- Water (7 day supply)
- Canned or Vacuum Packed Dry Food/Feed (7 day supply)
- Can opener
- Blanket
- Booties to protect feet
- Muzzle(s)
- Toys/Kongs/Treats
- Poop Bags/Shovels
- Laminated photos of animals/brands
- Laminated photos of "you & your pet(s)"
- Calming Medication
- Litter Pan/Litter
