The Riparian Corridor Ordinance, effective January 1st, 2015, was adopted by the Board of Supervisors to preserve and protect riparian corridors in Sonoma County. The Ordinance impacts all development, including commercial agricultural and grazing operations, within 200 feet of “blue line streams”. This free session will cover the impacts on agriculture and will help you determine if your property is affected. We will also discuss the Best Management Practices required for continued farming, setbacks for new agricultural operations, and the resources available to help you comply with this new regulation. We hope you will join us for this informative meeting as experts from the Sonoma County Department of Agriculture, Natural Resource Conservation Service, Sonoma Resource Conservation District, and the University of California Cooperative Extension introduce and discuss the Riparian Corridor Ordinance.
