

## Tehama County 4-H Events

“Participation” is defined as active involvement (not merely viewing from the audience) in, the following events:

**Club Officer Training** – Attend and complete all appropriate stations/activities or prepare and teach a station or activity. (You need not be an officer to participate.)

**County Presentation Day**– Give a presentation before the assigned judges, act as clerk or tabulator or act as room coordinator.

**Livestock Judging Day** - Judge all classes, act as clerk or tabulator, present a species or act as a judge.

**Fur and Feathers** – Show and exhibit your animal, act as clerk or tabulator.

**Still Exhibits Fair** – Prepare and enter your project work, work as a clerk or judge’s helper.

**Fashion Revue** – Enter a garment or outfit and model at the event, act as clerk, act as m/c and/or read commentary.

**Livestock Breeding & Market Prospect Show** – Prepare and enter your animal, act as clerk.

**4-H Open House** – Attend and participate in the event.

**Life Skills Judging Day** – Judge all classes, prepare a class to be judged, act as oral reasons judge or tabulator.

**Favorite Foods Day** – Prepare and enter food/table settings, etc, act as clerk or tabulator.

In order for concession stand participation to count as event participation, the member must contribute a significant amount of time at the stand working to the benefit of the stand and county event, length of time necessary to receive credit is at the discretion of the event host.
