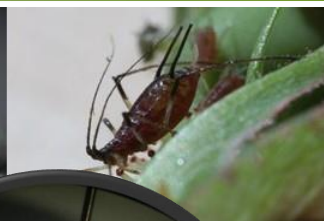


INSECT Identification Workshop: Predators, Parasitoids, & Pollinators May 19, 2016
