## WHAT IS HSP?

The Healthy Soils Program (HSP) is an incentive program designed to fund California farmers and ranchers to incorporate conservation management practices that improve their soil health, sequester carbon and reduce greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions.

The HSP Demonstration Projects is designed to show case California farmers and ranchers implementation of HSP practices. The program funds growers in partnership with education and research institutions to showcase practices to at least 120 producers over the course of the project (with or without research).
