



Program Evaluation Outcomes Quarterly Report

San Joaquin County

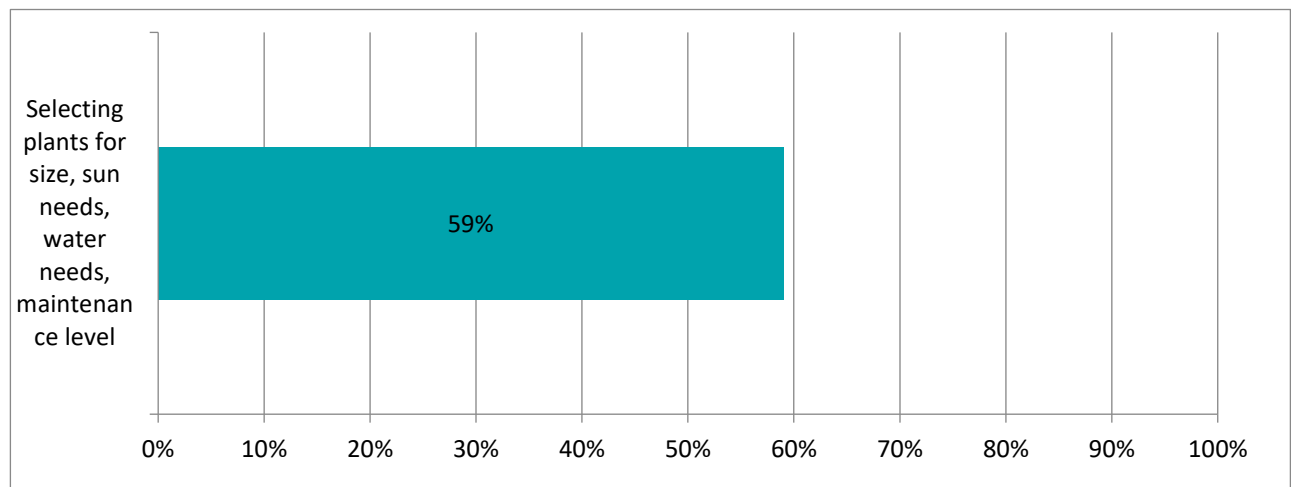
The goal of this survey is to examine behavior change in gardening practices among those who attend public education events led by UC Master Gardener volunteers. This cumulative report shows results from attendees who responded to the follow-up survey for events/workshops held between July 2018 and December 2018. Please note that attendees receive survey items for topics that were discussed during the event/workshop only. The statewide response rate for this reporting period is 32%.

Demographics

Data were collected from 48 respondents who attended 13 public education events. 61% of respondents were female; 79% were white, 7% were Asian, and 14% were other race; 5% were Hispanic; 2% of respondents were 18-30 years old, 63% were 51-70 years old and 35% were 71 or older.

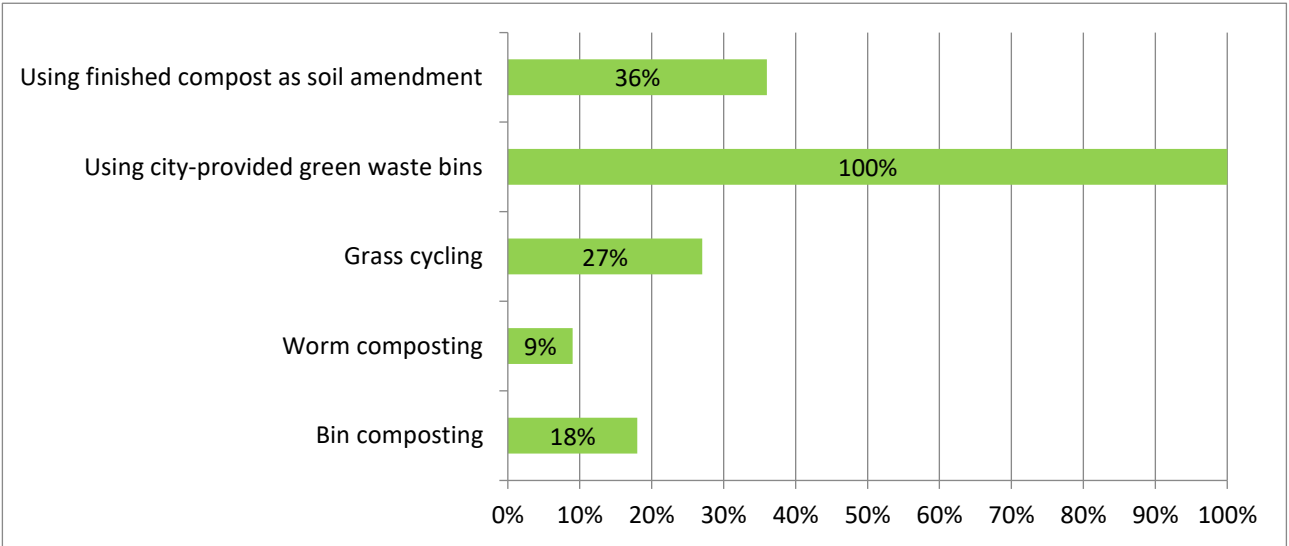

Right Plant Right Place (% respondents that started/improved practices)

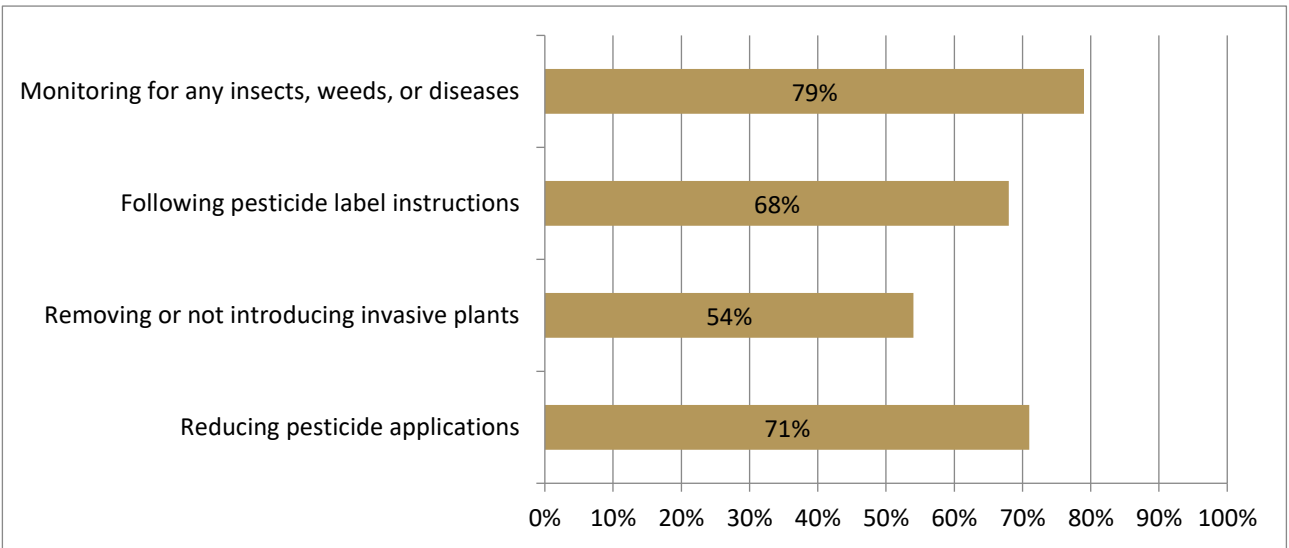




Green Waste (% respondents that started/improved practices)

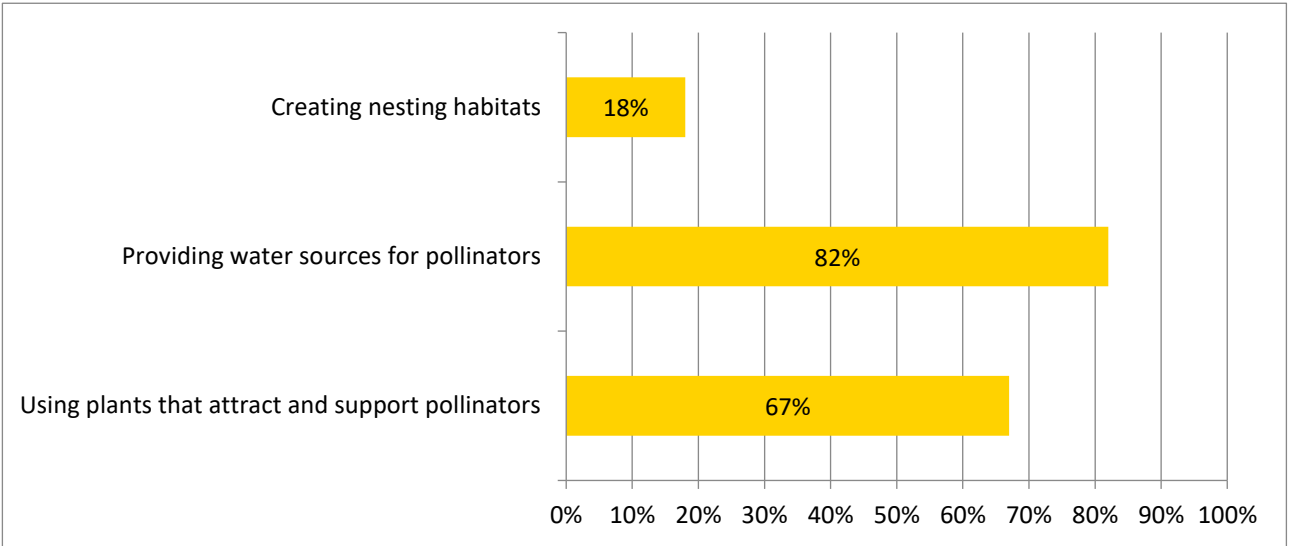


Pest Management (% respondents that started/improved practices)

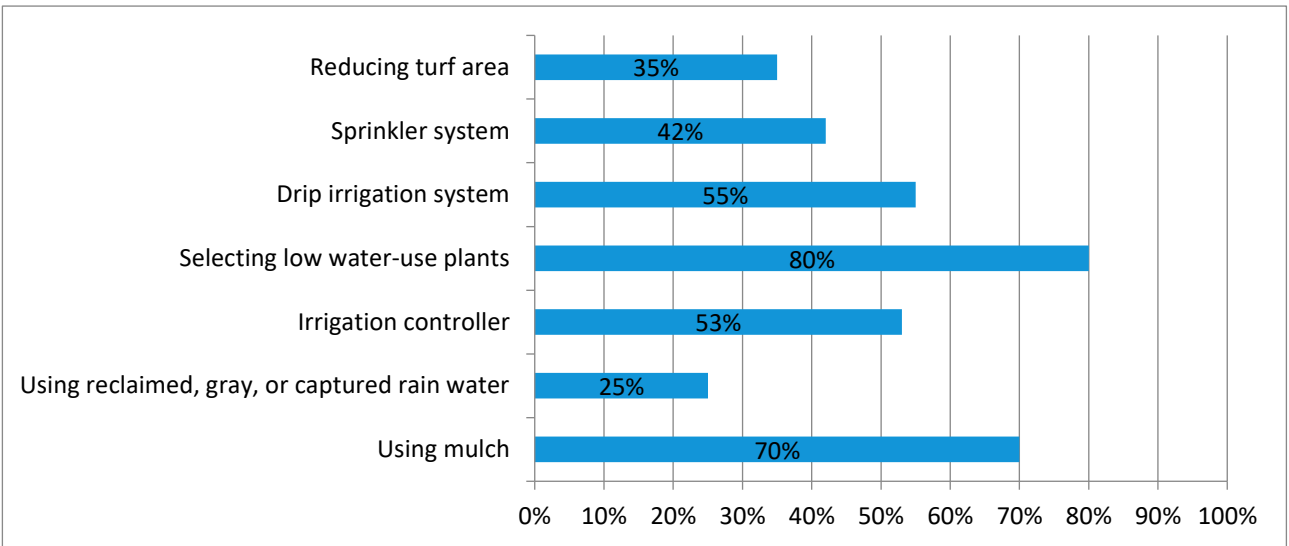




Pollinator-Friendly Gardens (% respondents that started/improved practices)

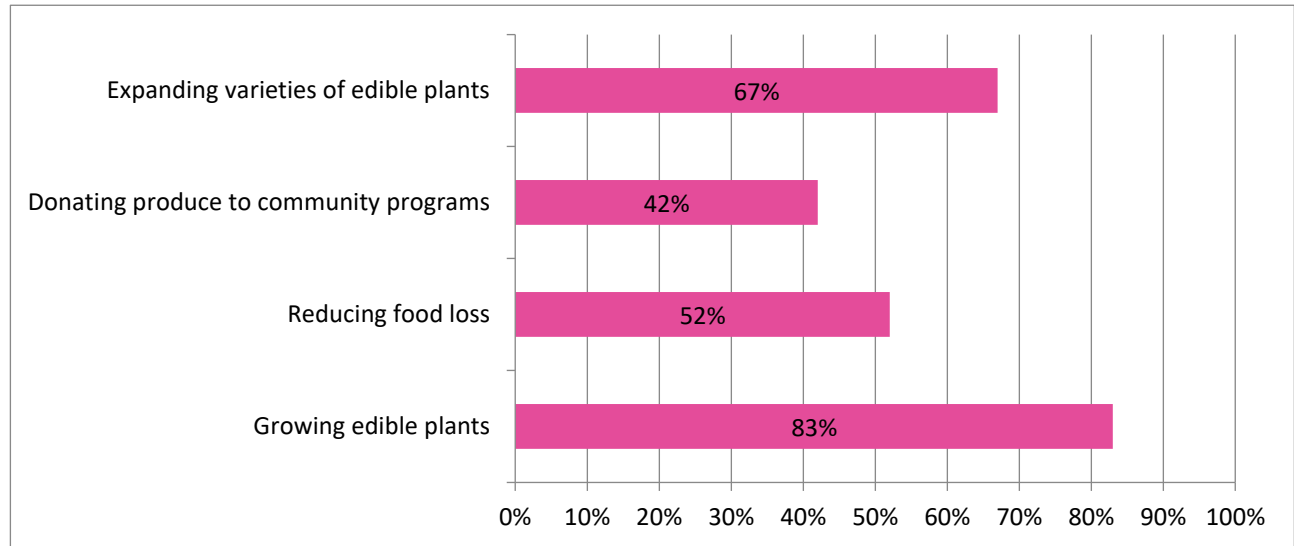


Water Conservation (% respondents that started/improved practices)

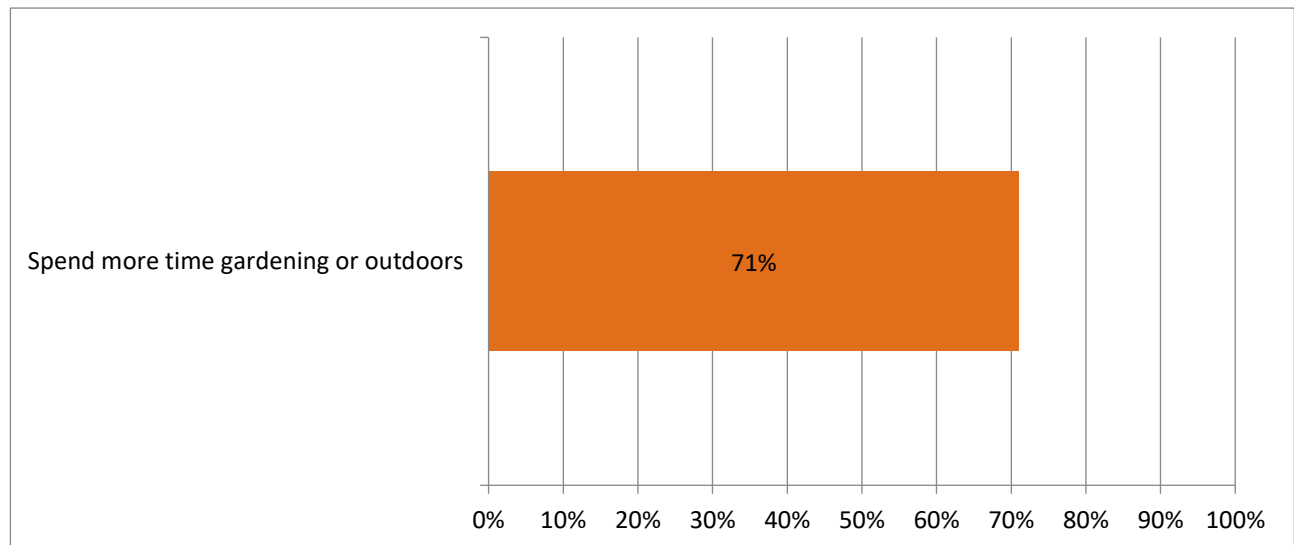




Food Gardening (% respondents that started/improved practices)
