What you need to know:

- **You must register online** and pay to receive the Zoom links by email.
- Once your registration is paid, you will have access to the website page with all course documents to print at home or read on your own screen.
- A computer screen is the best way to participate; if only a cell phone is available, you will need to print out the presentation materials to a readable size or request the binder at registration. You will also need to download the free Zoom app for phones for an acceptable participation experience.
- If you would like to receive a binder with printed training materials, you must indicate this in your registration and pick up the binder from the San Joaquin County Agricultural Center. Binders will not be mailed.
- Attendance at all classes and completion of quizzes with a passing grade are required for final qualification. Up to 2 classes may be made up by viewing the missed classes via recording; viewing will be verified, and recordings must be viewed before the course ends.
