<p><b>Brandywine Yellow</b></p>  <p>Totally Tomatoes</p>	<p><i>Beefsteak</i> - Prolific yields of golden-yellow, flattened, semi-irregular, up to 2 lb. fruits. Potato leaf.</p>		90 Days- Late Season	Indeterminate	Hybrid
<p><b>Cherokee Purple</b></p>  <p>Burpee</p>	<p><i>Beefsteak</i> - This large dark purple heirloom tomato from Tennessee is rumored to have come from Cherokee gardeners.
