

Curious about the life cycle of the salmon of the South Fork Noyo River?

Join California Department of Fish and Wildlife, Trout Unlimited, CAL FIRE and UCCE for a salmon spawning survey in the redwoods



In collaboration with partners, CDFW operates three intensive life cycle monitoring stations. The data gathered here is used to inform the rest of the salmon surveying in the region, which in turn guides efforts to help recover these vital species.

- How many redds (nests) do each salmon lay?
- How do biologists estimate the population size of salmon and steelhead in our local rivers?
- What can be done to restore salmon habitat in our local rivers?

These are a few of the questions being explored by the fish biologists you will meet on a cold day in January. **If we're lucky, and conditions allow, we'll have a chance to observe salmon spawning in the South Fork Noyo River.**
