



# Vegetable Families

## 3 year crop rotation

### COLE FAMILY

(Brassicaceae)

broccoli, cabbage,  
cauliflower, kohlrabi, kale,  
collards, radish, rutabaga,  
turnip, mustard, tatsoi

### PEA FAMILY

(Fabaceae, Leguminosae)

beans, peas, fava beans,  
runner beans, cowpeas,  
lentils, garbanzo beans,  
peanuts

### ONION FAMILY

(Amaryllidaceae, Alliaceae)

garlic, onions, leeks, chives,  
shallots

### SQUASH FAMILY

(Cucurbitaceae)

cucumbers, gourds,  
melons, summer squash,  
winter squash, pumpkins

### TOBACCO FAMILY

(Solanaceae)

tomatoes, potatoes,  
peppers, eggplant

### GRASS FAMILY

(Gramineae, Poaceae)

corn, rice, barley, wheat,  
oats, rye, millet, sorghum

### BEET FAMILY

(Chenopodiaceae)

beets, mangels, spinach,  
chard, quinoa, orache

### PARSLEY FAMILY

(Umbelliferae, Apiaceae)

carrots, parsnips, celery,  
parsley, fennel, cilantro

### MORNING GLORY FAMILY

(Convolvulaceae)

Sweet potato

### SUNFLOWER FAMILY

(Compositae, Asteraceae)

lettuce, endive, sunflower

### MALLOW FAMILY

(Malvaceae)

okra

***For instance: if you plant broccoli in a section of your garden, then you will not plant any other cole family crop in that section for two more years.***
