Fun with Fashion Event is being held on Saturday, May 13, 2023

JOIN IN THE FUN: You are invited to join in the Fun with Fashion event on Saturday, May 13th 2023. Location: San Luis Obispo United Methodist Church, 1515 Fredericks St., San Luis Obispo, CA 93405.

This event is limited to 60 participants. You do not have to be in a sewing project to enter this county Fun with Fashion event; however, Traditional, Make It With Wool and Quilt categories do require enrollment in a 4-H Clothing & Sewing Project to advance onto the State Field Day (SFD) and Fashion Revue on May 27th, 2023 at UC Davis. Check-in is from 8:30 a.m. – 9:00 a.m. These events will run from 9:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. 4-H members of all ages can enter this event.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE: All regular 4-H Members entering these events must be a member of good standing in the current 4-H Program Year (7/1/22-6/30/23) which means that you have completed the enrollment process and you are enrolled in at least 1 project and that you comply with the 4-H Member of Conduct. Members can be enrolled in any project to enter this event. We encourage all regular members to enter at least 2 separate categories, but you can enter a maximum of 4 categories total - (limit 1 entry per Category). In order to submit an entry, 4-H members must be present and participate in these events.

FUN WITH FASHION EVENT– see Table of Contents page for Categories to enter.

Primary Member Participants: Primary Members (5 years of age to 8 years of age as of December 31, 2022) may participate in this event. However, Primary Members must have a parent or guardian with them throughout the entire event, including activities. Primary Members receive a Participation Ribbon and Certificate following the State 4-H guidelines.

ENTRY FEES

There will be a \$5 Registration Fee per person (not per category entry) for this event. The \$5.00 Registration fee can be via cash or check. Checks are payable to SLO CO 4-H YDP and are due by Friday, April 28th, 2023. Please Mail or Drop off your Registration Fee to: 4-H Office, 2156 Sierra Way, Suite # C, San Luis Obispo, CA 93401. 4-H Clubs are not responsible for any of the registration fee final payment this year. 4-H Members are responsible for their own Registration Fee payment.

ENTRIES, JUDGING, AND AWARDS

All entries must be the work of the 4-H member. To set up the entries, only members can place their items along with their 3 x 5 Description card(s) in the Staging area when they arrive. The 3x5 card can be used during the Interview with the Judges, as members will be asked to discuss their entry. Certificates are awarded to all members. The Danish system of judging is used to determine individual awards, which are based on merit, as determined by the Judges. A Medal will be awarded to Regular 4-H members (Ages 9-19) receiving at least two gold seals on their entries. Members are encouraged to enter more than one Category to qualify for a Medal – a maximum of 4 entries per member is allowed (1 entry per Category). Primary Members will receive a Participation Ribbon and Certificate. All judging is closed to the public, and the Judging Area is Restricted until all judging is complete.

MEMBERS with FABRIC ITEMS -- CONSTRUCTION JUDGING Information:

Fabric Items Construction Judging will be done at the event for all members who created a fabric item. You may wear your garment to the event for the Modeling portion of the event; **then for the Construction Judging portion**. Please bring a change of clothes in a paper bag – with your Name and Club Name on it – then before the Fabric Construction Judging is ready, you will change into your other clothes and put your Fabric Garment in a paper bag or on a hanger for the Fashion Construction Judges to judge your fabric garment. Make sure the bag or hanging Garment has your name and club name on it.

PARENT / ADULT PARTICIPATION – VOLUNTEERING OPPORTUNITY

Parents, guardians, and other adults are welcome to attend these events. All adults who wish to stay will sign in at the Registration Table at these events.

All 4-H members and their entries must be picked up by 12:30 p.m. Entries will not be kept by the 4-H Office, the entries will be disposed of after each event if they are not picked up by 12:30 p.m.

CONCLUSION OF EVENTS: All 4-H Members will participate in the clean-up activity at the conclusion of the event.

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Consumer Science Purchased \$50 Limit Category

General Requirements:

- Open to all members currently enrolled and in good standing in a SLO County 4-H Club.
- Only one (1) entry is allowed in this category.
- All entries must have been made during the current year (7/1/22 to 6/30/23).
- Participants in this category will shop for an entire outfit with the total cost not to exceed \$50.00 not including sales tax. Receipts from the current 4-H year are required for any item that is visible. This includes but is not limited to shoes, stockings, jewelry, and hair accessories. Gifts, prior purchases, and items without receipts are not eligible for this category. Receipts from yard sales, etc. may be handwritten. The member should consider value vs. cost, versatility, the shopping experience, and coordination of the outfit within the cost limit. This category has no 4-H project requirement and must be modeled by the member at the SLO County Fashion Show & **State 4-H Fashion Revue** events.

What to Bring:

- Your completed item.
- **The member must bring a 3" x 5" card typed, or neatly printed, with a brief description of how the entry was made. Member can use this card when presenting entry to the judge and to answer questions including the knowledge & preparation of entry. Please write member's name and club name on reverse side of the card.**

Judging Criteria

Workmanship – coordinated well on overall outfit

Creativity – shoppable and versatile

Cost versus Value – value of items match cost

Costume Challenge/Accessory Items Category

General Requirements:

- Open to all members currently enrolled and in good standing in a SLO County 4-H Club.
- Only one (1) entry is allowed in this category.
- All entries must have been made during the current year (7/1/22 to 6/30/23).
- Participants in this category will create a costume for themselves or another person using any technique, materials, or pattern. It does not need to be sewn from fabric. The costume can be any theme and from any time, place, or country as long as it is 4-H appropriate. 70% of the costume must be handmade by the member; 30% can be handmade or purchased. The member must be able to move comfortably in the costume – sit, stand, walk, and go up and down stairs.
- This category has not 4-H project requirement. If it was sewn for the member, they must model it. If it was sewn for another person, that person may model it, or it may be shown on a hanger. The member must be present and participate at the Fashion Show event if it was sewn for another person.

What to Bring:

- Your completed item.
- **The member must bring a 3” x 5” card typed, or neatly printed, with a brief description of how the entry was made. Member can use this card when presenting entry to the judge and to answer questions including the knowledge & preparation of entry. Please write member’s name and club name on reverse side of the card.**

Judging Criteria

Workmanship – construction details & use of materials to enhance costume

Creativity – thorough knowledge of character or theme, techniques and skill; member should be knowledgeable of discussing costume and it’s theme

Appearance – presents outfit with confidence; use of gestures to complement outfit, appearance to accent costume

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Leather Creations Category

General Requirements:

- Open to all members currently enrolled and in good standing in a SLO County 4-H Club.
- Only one (1) entry is allowed in this category.
- All entries must have been made during the current year (7/1/22 to 6/30/23).
- Participants in this category will create any leather accessory – purse, wallet, belt, saddlebag, key fob, etc. – in any style. Any leather techniques may be used (tooling, carving, dyeing, painting, shaping, stitching, etc.). Materials used may be any leather, suede, or faux leather products.
- This category has no 4-H Project Requirement and must be shown by the member at the event.

What to Bring:

- Your completed item.
- **The member must bring a 3” x 5” card typed, or neatly printed, with a brief description of how the entry was made. Member can use this card when presenting entry to the judge and to answer questions including the knowledge & preparation of entry. Please write member’s name and club name on reverse side of the card.**

Judging Criteria

Workmanship – patterns used are neat, organized & understood; well-constructed techniques used

Creativity – correct use of materials; item appropriate for intended use & age of member; style & use of designs enhances item

Appearance – good use of materials; put together well; thorough knowledge of item care, construction materials and tools used

Make It With Wool Category

General Requirements:

- Open to all members currently enrolled and in good standing in a SLO County 4-H Club.
- Only one (1) entry is allowed in this category.
- All entries must have been made during the current year (7/1/22 to 6/30/23).
- Participants in this category will sew, knit, or crochet garment(s) from 100% wool, wool blend (minimum of 60% wool) fabric or yarn or specialty wool fiber. Specialty fibers include alpaca, angora, camel, cashmere, llama, mohair, and vicuna. The entire garment body (front, back, and sleeves) must be wool or wool-blend fabric. Vests worn with a suit, sport coat, or blazer may have a back of non-wool fabric. Vests worn as a top layer or with outerwear coat/jacket must have a wool back. Trims, facings, interfacings, linings, and/or under linings may be fabrics other than wool or wool blends. Hand-spun yarns and/or hand-woven fabrics may be used and must meet above criteria.
- Garments created for the Make It With Wool competition that is supported by the American Sheep Industry meet the requirements for this category: <https://makeitwithwool.com/welcome>
- If you choose to enter the Make It With Wool competition, it is your responsibility to ensure that your entry meets the Make It With Wool requirements: <https://makeitwithwool.com/the-facts>
- **The garment(s) in this category must be sewn by the member as part of a 4-H Clothing & Textiles Project and modeled by the member at the Fashion Show event.**

What to Bring:

- Your completed item.

The member must bring a 3" x 5" card typed, or neatly printed, with a brief description of how the entry was made. Member can use this card when presenting entry to the judge and to answer questions including the knowledge & preparation of entry. Please write member's name and club name on reverse side of the card.

Judging Criteria

Workmanship – fit of garment enhances overall appearance

Creativity – learning skills challenged; appropriate use of wool types

Appearance - poise/posture, well groomed, garment fits/accents member appropriately

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Poem Category

General Requirements:

- Open to 4-H members currently enrolled and in good standing in a SLO County 4-H club.
- Only **one (1)** entry in this Category is allowed.

Poem Descriptions:

- **Memorization is Not Required.**
- **Member must provide a 2nd neat copy of the complete poem for the judge. Also prepare a 3 x 5 card neatly typed or printed with a brief description of why the poem was selected. Write name and club name on the reverse side of the card.**
- Introduction to Poem/Creativity: Content (intro and conclusion analysis) was appropriate for presenter’s ability. **What is the Reason for choosing this poem?**
- Structure: Body: Selected reading was well selected/edited; Smooth transition; Length was within 1-5 minutes.
- Mechanics of Presenting: Poise & confidence, Eye contact with audience, Included expression: verbal: projection, tone, speech rate
- Appearance: Appropriate attire for the occasion; response to questions. Member can dress-up to enhance the poem reading.

What to Bring:

- Your prepared Poem with a 2nd copy to hand to the judge.
- **3”x 5” card with information (see instructions above)**

Judging Criteria:

Creativity: Content, intro & conclusion analysis; appropriate for presenter’s ability

Structure: body of poem well selected/edited; smooth transition, length

Mechanics of Presenting: Poise, expression, eye contact, confidence

Informational Value: Reasons for choosing poem, appearance, response to questions

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Poster/Collage Category

General Requirements:

- Open to all members currently enrolled and in good standing in a SLO County 4-H club.
- Only one (1) entry is allowed in this Category.
- Posters should be educational in nature about a subject; a title is required.
- Collages are a collection of themed pictures; a title is optional.
- Include information about the subject. Keep it simple. It must be legible from three feet away.
- Poster or collage size should be a minimum of 22" x 28" & maximum of 22" x 30", **in a portrait/vertical layout** (not landscape/horizontal) and ready for display.
- **Regular** or **foam** poster board may be used.
- **No Trifold Posters.**
- **Print your name and club name on the back top right corner of the poster.**

What to Bring:

- Your completed poster or collage.
- **The member must bring a 3" x 5" card typed, or neatly printed, with a brief description of how entry was made. Member can use this card when presenting entry to the judge and to answer questions including the knowledge & preparation of entry. Please write member's Name and Club name on Reverse Side of the card.**

Judging Criteria

Quality of Construction – Is the layout and design neat and orderly?

Subject Content – Is the theme carried out and appropriate to the title?

Informational Value – Is it informative? Is the message clear and accurate?

Originality and Creativity – Is the color coordination and design complementary?

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Quilts Category

General Requirements:

- Open to 4-H members currently enrolled and in good standing in a SLO County 4-H club.
- Only one (1) entry is allowed in this Category.
- Participants in this category will sew a quilt of any size and pattern. The quilt must have finished edges and may use any quilting method (machine, hand, hand-tie, etc.).
- **The item(s) in this category must be sewn by the member as part of a 4-H Clothing & Textiles Project and shown by the member at the event.**

What to Bring:

- Your completed item – OR – your Quilt can be a “work in progress” item.
- **Include a 3” x 5” card, typed, or neatly printed, with a brief description of how the entry was made, and the recycled item(s) and other materials used. Member needs to be able to discuss the item and its creation to the Judge. Members can use this card when presenting entry to the judge and to answer questions including the knowledge & preparation of entry. Please write member’s name, club, on reverse side of the card.**

Judging Criteria:

Creativity – pleasing to look at: harmonious colors, material choices are suitable

Design – well planned construction; knowledge of fabric and techniques

Appearance - neat and clean, effective presentation

Workmanship – well constructed; points and corners are precise, backing, binding and accessories accent quilt

Interview with Judges – confidence & self-assured when discussing construction of quilt

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Softie Challenge Guidelines Category

General Requirements:

- Open to 4-H members currently enrolled and in good standing in a SLO County 4-H club.
- Only one (1) entry is allowed in this Category.
- **What is a Softie?** A stuffed animal, cloth doll, plush toy, soft sculpture, or fabric toy. In this challenge, the participant will sew, felt, knit, or crochet a softie using a pattern or their own design. Any type of fabric and any embellishment techniques (trims, yarn hair, removeable clothing) may be used.
- This category has no 4-H project requirement and must be shown by the member at the event.
- Participant must present the entry themselves at the event.

What to Bring:

- Your completed item
- **Include a 3" x 5" card, typed, or neatly printed, with a brief description of how the entry was made, and the recycled item(s) and other materials used. Member needs to be able to discuss the item and its creation to the Judge. Members can use this card when presenting entry to the judge and to answer questions including the knowledge & preparation of entry. Please write member's name, club, on reverse side of the card.**

Judging Criteria:

Creativity/Design - Materials used in a unique way; skills challenged

Appearance – all materials used complement item; accessories enhance overall look, neat and clean

Workmanship – well-constructed techniques used; object suitable for intended purpose

Interview with Judges – member has knowledge and techniques in construction

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Non-Wearable Textile Arts Category (Not eligible for State Fashion Revue)

- Open to all members currently enrolled and in good standing in a SLO County 4-H club.
- Only one (1) entry in this category is allowed.
- Item must be made by the member.
- Entries must be made within the current project year (7/1/22-6/30/23).
- Entries can be any hand-crafted or sewn item that is not considered clothing and is not modeled by itself.
- Entries can be (but not limited to) embroidery, needlepoint, and sewing.

Examples of Acceptable Entries:

- Doll Clothes / Potholders / Afghans/Quilt made of material fabric (Not knitted or crocheted)
- Felted items / Cross stitch / Pillows / Pillowcases / Table Linens
- Purses / Bags / Scarf / Hats
- Lampshade Covers with fabric/Trash Can covered with fabric/Fabric picture frames

What to Bring:

- Your completed item
- **Include a 3" x 5" card, typed, or neatly printed, with a brief description of how the entry was made, and the recycled item(s) and other materials used. Member needs to be able to discuss the item and its creation to the Judge. Members can use this card when presenting entry to the judge and to answer questions including the knowledge & preparation of entry. Please write member's name, club, on reverse side of the card.**

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Traditional Category

- Open to all members currently enrolled and in good standing in a SLO County 4-H club.
- Only one (1) entry in this category is allowed.
- Item must be made by the member.
- Entries must be made within the current project year (7/1/22-6/30/23).
- Participants in this category will construct a garment(s) and assemble an outfit that showcases their sewing skills and ability to coordinate an outfit.
- Garments need to meet CA 4-H Dress Guidelines <https://4h.ucanr.edu/files/210170.pdf>
- The outfit must contain at least one constructed garment. Participants are encouraged to construct additional garments to complete the outfit but may wear clothing they purchased or already own.
- Accessories-such as shoes, hats, belts, jewelry, purses, backpacks, etc. may be purchased, already owned, or made by the member.
- If items were sewn that cannot be worn – such as in a coordinating jacket, skirt, and pants set or in a pajama set with matching pillow or quilt – these additional items may be carried.
- Only garments sewn by the participant will be evaluated on Construction, but all items worn will be evaluated on the outfit configuration.
- **The garment(s) in this category must be sewn by the member as part of a 4-H Clothing & Textiles Project and modeled by the member at the event.**

What to Bring:

- Your completed item
- **Include a 3” x 5” card, typed, or neatly printed, with a brief description of how the entry was made. Member needs to be able to discuss the item and its creation to the Judge.
