2023 Plant Sale: House Plants, Herbs, Flowering Ornamental & Natives, Roses, Succulents

House Plants

- 6 Spider Plant *Chlorophytum comosum*
- 3 Wandering Jew *Tradescantia sabrina*

Herbs

- 13 Borage *Borago officinalis*
Annual herb with cucumber-scented leaves and small blue flowers. Loved by pollinators.
- 2 Cinnamon Basil *Ocimum basilicum*
Basil with a spicy, cinnamon flavor and scent
- 5 English Thyme *Thymus vulgaris*
Low growing perennial culinary herb

Flowering, Natives & Ornamental Plants

- 12 **Bachelor's Buttons – Red** *Centaurea cyanus*
Vibrant red edible flowers with sweet spice reminiscent of cloves. Deer resistant.
- 6 **Bachelor's Buttons – Black** *Centaurea cyanus*
Dark purple flower that's edible or great for cut flowers.
- 22 **Bee Balm – Lemon** *Monarda citriodora*
Member of the mint family and herbaceous native that produces tall, spiked clusters of lavender flowers
- 9 **Blue Grama Grass** *Bouteloua graciliw*
Grows to 3' and has horizontal eyelash flowers that age to blonde seed heads. Low water native.
- 12 **Calendula – Oopsy Daisy** *Calendula officinalis*
Compact type with profusion of single/double flowers in orange & cream with fiery orange tips
- 12 **Calendula – Pink Surprise** *Calendula officinalis*
Frilly flowers in shades of pink-tinged apricot
- 12 **Calendula – Strawberry Blonde** *Calendula officinalis*
Creamy coral petals have bright red backs. Edible. Great for cut or dried flowers.
- 7 **Cosmos – Apricot Lemonade** *Cosmos sulphureus*
Blooms have a combination of lemon, pink and apricot.
- 7 **Cosmos – Dazzler** *Cosmos bipinnatus*
Bold carmine blooms with gold center. Suitable for cutting.
- 10 **Craspedia (Drumstick Flower)** *Pycnosorus globosus*
Blooms are bright yellow orbs – perfect for cut or dried flowers. Drought tolerant.

Flowering, Natives & Ornamental Plants cont.

- 3 **Dusty Miller** *Artemisia stelleriana*
Grey leaved plant
- 12 **Feverfew** *Tanacetum parthenium*
Herb with daisy-like flowers.
- 6 **Geranium "Vancouver Centennial"** *Pelargonium "Vancouver Centennial"*
Russet leaves edged in chartreuse with single, bright orange/red flowers on low, spreading plants. Frost tender.
- 5 **Goldenrod** *Solidage velutina ssp californica*
Clump forming tall perennial wildflowers with spiky, golden blooms that are loved by pollinators.
- 13 **Hollyhock** *Alcea Rosea*
Assorted Colors.
- 5 **Hummingbird Sage**
Blooming sage favored by pollinators
- 8 **Marigold – Brocade** *Tagetes patula*
12-18" tall plants with ruffly bronze, orange and yellow blooms.
- 12 **Marigold – French Blend** *Tagetes patula*
Pungent, single blooms in gold, red and orange.
- 4 **Marigold – Red Metamorph** *Tagetes patula*
Rusty red petals surround bright yellow centers. Single flowered and grows to 24" tall.
- 3 **Mock Orange** *Philadelphus lewisii*
Fragrant white blooms on multi-stemmed shrub with long arching branches.

Flowering, Natives & Ornamental Plants cont.

- 6 **Morning Glory** *Convolvulus sabaticus*
Climbing annual with morning blooms
- 3 **Nasturtium** *Tropaeolum majus*
Edible flowers have a peppery bite.
- 3 **Salvia – Bee Bliss** *Salvia leucophylla* “Bee Bliss”
Low growing native with green-gray leaves and blue flower spikes. Bees love it!
- 5 **Scabiosa – Black Knight** *Scabiosa atropurpurea*
Black-burgundy flowers on long stems. Great for cut flowers. Attractive to bees.
- ? **Society Garlic**
Ornamental garlic with lavender/pink flowers
- 14 **Sweet Peas** *Lathyrus odorata*
Ornamental pea with fragrant blooms on long stems. Excellent for bouquets
- 4 **Verbena** *Verbena bonariensis*
Tall verbena with clusters of lavender flowers atop woody stems. Good for pollinators
- 6 **Western Blue Flax (Native)** *Linum lewisii*
Native perennial with delicate blue flowers. Self sows. Flowers profusely with some water
- 10 **Zinnia – Cut and Come Again** *Zinnia elegans*
Multi-hued zinnias on tall stems bloom all summer
- 10 **Zinnia – Margareni** *Zinnia elegans*
Eye-catching double flowers in shades of orange and gold.

Roses

- 1 **Ballerina**
- 2 **Baron Prevost**
- 2 **Cecile Brunner 1894** *Rosa 'cecile brunner'*
aka "Sweetheart Rose". Vigorous climber with perfect miniature buds. Light pink with sweet/spicy scent. Does not repeat.
- 4 **Climbing American Beauty** *Rosa 'american beauty'*
Hybrid perpetual. Climber with globular varying pink blooms. May repeat.
- 3 **Crepuscule**
- 1 **Damask Rose (shrub)**
- 1 **Dutcher**
- 6 **Gatewood San Andreas**
- 4 **Irene's Pink (not a Heritage nor grown in HRG)**
- 2 **Jackson Gate Neighbor**
- 1 **Jackson Gate Pink**
Hybrid perpetual. Bushy shrub with pink blooms in spring. Very hardy.
- 10 **Lady Banks Yellow** *Rosa banksiae*
Yellow thornless, evergreen climbing rose. NOT FROM HRG
- 5 **Like Lamarque**
- 1 **Moser House Hybrid Perpetual**
- 5 **Mutablis** *Rosa chinensis 'mutablis'*
Showy single blossoms that change color – yellow/pink/crimson. Flowers in flushes.
- 1 **Mystery Rose**

Roses cont.

- 3 **Old Red Runaround**
- 1 **North Bloomfield Raspberry**
- 1 **Rosa alba (sucker)**
- 1 **Rosa foetida (sucker)**
- 4 **Rosa nutkana (Native)** *Rosa nutkana*
Medium, upright shrub produces single, lavender-pink blooms with pronounced stamen. Conspicuous hips.
- 3 **Rosa odorata**
- 1 **Tuscany Superb (sucker in 5 gal container)**
- 1 **White Moss**
- 1 **Zephirine Drouhin**
