Cucumber

| 16 | Armenian | <i>Cucumis melo</i> | Pale green, mild tasting and deeply ribbed. Vining type. (genetically a melon) |
| 10 | Dragon Suhyo Hybrid | <i>Cucumis sativus</i> | Asian cucumber with long, dark fruits and thin skin. Prolific and flavorful. Vining type |
| 8 | Fresh Pickles Hybrid | <i>Cucumis sativus</i> | 3-5" fruit on compact plants. Prolific. |
| 15 | Japanese Long | <i>Cucumis sativus</i> | Long, thin-skin variety. Burpless. |
| 18 | Lemon cucumber | <i>Cucumis sativus</i> | Round, yellow trellis type with sweet flavor and no bitterness |
| 8 | Olympian | <i>Cucumis sativus</i> | Hybrid slicing type (Marketmore) with good disease resistance and long production |
| 10 | Straight 8 | <i>Cucumis sativus</i> | Slicing type with green skin, firm flesh and small seeds have excellent texture/flavor. Harvest at 8" long. Best grown on trellis. |
| 15 | Striped Armenian | <i>Cucumis melo</i> | Alternate dark and light green stripes. Performs best with adequate irrigation and warm soil. Can be grown on trellis. |
| 8 | Sumter | <i>Cucumis sativus</i> | Pickling type that's also suitable for slicing. Blocky, medium-green fruit with spines. Needs warm, well-drained soil and consistent water. |
| 10 | Tasty Green | <i>Cucumis sativus</i> | Thin skin, Japanese type with crunchy texture and sweet flavor |

Eggplant

- 11 **Annina** *Solanum melongena*
Spineless plants produce lavender and cream striped fruit with good flavor and low seed count.
- 8 **Fairy Tale**
Small purple/white streaked mini eggplant with few seeds
- 2 **Listada de Gandia**
Light purple and cream streaked Italian variety bears flavorful plum-shaped fruit.
- 8 **Long Purple**
8-10" long dark purple fruit with creamy texture. Asian variety
- 15 **Ping tung Long**
Asian variety with long, slender purple fruit.
- 5 **Rolandia**
Oval, dark purple fruit up to 8". Spineless. Productive with good flavor.
- 10 **Rosa Bianca**
White with lavender. Mild flesh.

Melon

- 30 **Ambrosia** *Cucumis melo*
Hybrid cantaloupe with extra-sweet nectar-like flavor. Popular variety.
- ? **D'artagnan**
Early maturing, small Charentais melon with delicious floral tones/fragrant
- 10 **Crenshaw** *Cucumis melo var.inodourous*
Cross between a Casaba and Cantaloupe. Sweet flesh.
- 20 **Crimson Sweet Watermelon** *Cucurbitaceae Citrullus lanatus*
Crisp, sweet with med-red flesh and mild flavor. Needs rich soil and good water
- 14 **Hale's Best Cantaloupe**
Heirloom. 4-lb fruits with plants that are powdery mildew resistant. Sweet and aromatic

Melon cont.

- ? **Petit Gris de Rennes**
French heirloom produces small, 2-3 lb fruit. Sweet and perfumed. Adapted to cool climates.
- 10 **Sierra Gold**
Small, 2 lb. Cantaloupe with heavy netting and sweet flesh.
- 12 **Wilson's Sweet Watermelon** *Citrillus vulgaris*
Green mottled rind with crisp, sweet red flesh with rich watermelon flavor. Large.

Pepper

- 1 **Aji Mango**
Tangerine in color with hot mango flavors
- 12 **Anaheim** *Capsicum annuum*
Green, New Mexico style perfect for roasting. Mildly-hot
- 12 **Big Jim Jalapeno**
Large, 5" jalapeno
- 2 **Blot**
Colorful blotches of burnt orange & purple on light colored bell. Quite flavorful.
- 10 **Buena Mulata** *Capsicum annuum*
Smaller plant suitable for containers. Edible peppers are thin and long and start out purple, ripening to red. Medium Hot.
- 8 **Caballo** *Capsicum pubescens*
Rocoto-type pear-shape pepper size of small bell but with medium heat and nice flavor.
- 3 **California Wonder Bell Pepper**
Standard for bell peppers produce large, fleshy fruits
- 4 **Cayenne Long**
Very Hot. Slender, long peppers turn bright red. Popular for drying and grinding into powder
- 1 **Chiltepin**
Small, round pepper that is very hot. Citrusy flavor. Wild pepper native to the southwest.
- 10 **Corbaci**
Long, red salad type

Pepper cont.

- 10 **Cornito Giallo**
Smaller Italian style sweet pepper (5-6") that ripens to bright gold.
- 4 **Craig's Grande Jalapeno**
Large, fat jalapeno variety
- 3 **Datil**
Blazing hot, blunt little 3 inch fruit in brilliant orange color.
- 3 **Etuda**
Rich, sweet citrus flavor in extra-large mandarin-orange bell pepper.
- 8 **Fish**
African hot pepper used in fish/shellfish cookery. Attractive foliage.
- 2 **Golden Cal Wonder**
Sweet bell pepper ripens to bright gold. Large, fleshy fruit.
- 3 **Gorogong**
Habanero-type pepper in canary yellow. Very hot!
- 20 **Green Bell**
Mild flavored crisp, thick flesh. Classic bell pepper
- 15 **Guajillo**
Medium-hot, spicy and fruity flavor. Ripens to red peppers 5-6" long. Used for drying and in mole and sauces.
- 34 **Gypsy**
Hybrid cross of Italian bull horn and bell pepper. Orange fruit is sweet and great for snacking or cooking.
- 7 **Habanada**
Heatless variety of habanero. Fruity & floral flavors.
- 3 **Italian Pepperocini**
Small, thin pepper perfect for eating or pickling. Mild heat.
- 36 **Jalapeno**
Medium Hot. 3" peppers born on compact plants. Great for salsa, cooking.

Pepper cont.

- 5 **Jalapeno Pumpkin Spice**
Lightly spicy with sweet, fruity flavor. Low heat.
- 15 **Jigsaw**
Ornamental and edible hot pepper. Tie dye patterns of lavender, cream, violet and green. Great in containers.
- 6 **Joe Parker**
Red chili from mild to warm heat
- 2 **King of the North**
Early, good-sized green bell that ripens to red.
- 5 **Lemon Drop** *capsicum baccatum*
Seasoning pepper from Peru. Lemon yellow fruit with purple blush. Citrusy heat on thin-walled conical fruit.
- 4 **Mild Jalapeno**
Low-heat variety of Jalapeno.
- 10 **Oranos**
Sweet snacking pepper that's bright orange and flavorful. Tall, prolific plants.
- 8 **Poblano**
Mildly Hot. Heart-shaped pepper for stuffing or cooking. Called Ancho when dried.
- 6 **Puya**
Used for drying. 3" long hot but fruity flavors. Used in sauces
- 3 **Rainforest**
1 to 2" cherry red fruit. Crisp with subtle sweet flesh and medium heat.
- 20 **Red Bell**
Classic red bell pepper
- 2 **Rewia**
Mild flavor, thick flesh and super sweet & juicy.
- 20 **Serrano**
Very Hot. Slender 3-4" pepper harvested green, ripens to red. Abundant producer. Great in salsa or cooking
- 2 **Sheep Nose Pimiento**
Sweet pepper. Round, oblate and ribbed red pepper.

Pepper cont.

- 40 **Shishito**
Japanese variety with mild heat. Typically harvested when 2-4" long, matures to red. Great for roasting, grilling.
- 14 **Sugar Rush Peach** *Capsicum baccatum*
Heirloom.. Long, peach colored fruits with super sweet tropical flavor. Seeds bring smoky, complex heat.
- 20 **Sweet Banana**
Sweet. Prolific. Ripens from green to yellow to red. Great for eating and pickling with good flavor
- 1 **Thai Red Chili**
Fiery little pointed peppers suitable for drying.
- 4 **Thunderbolt**
Hybrid Marconi-style sweet pepper with prolific yields of long, red sweet peppers. Disease resistant.
- 4 **Tabasco** *Capsicum frutescens*
Very hot thin pepper famous for its sauce.
- 3 **Tunisian Baklouti** *Capsicum annuum*
Long , red tapering pods with wonderful hot flavor that gets milder with cooking. Traditional Tunisian pepper

Squash – Summer

- 15 **Black Beauty Zucchini** *Cucurbita pepo*
Dark green fruit borne on prolific bush-type plants. Early.
- ? **Golden Egg Zucchini**
Spherical, golden-yellow egg-shape with delicious creamy flesh. High yielding.
- 12 **Golden PattyPan**
Bright gold round, flat squash with delicious flesh
- ? **Latino F1 Zucchini**
Cocozelle type with dark and light green striping on ridged fruit.
- 6 **Long White of Palermo Zucchini**
Heirloom. Long sage green fruit with speckles. Buttery and nutty flavor.
- 6 **Nimba Zucchini**
Early variety, good for cool or short season areas. Medium green.

Squash – Summer cont.

- ? **Ronde de Nice**
French heirloom round, green zucchini great for stuffing.
- 54 **Straightneck Yellow**
Lemon-yellow club-shaped fruit. Firm flesh tender & delicious
- 8 **Yellow Crookneck**
Bright yellow, lightly bumpy fruit known for its buttery flavor and firm texture. Best picked small.

Squash – Winter

- 8 **Delicata** *Cucurbita pepo*
Creamy skin with long dark green striping. Mild & lightly sweet flesh with tender skin. Great for stuffing.
- 6 **Lakota** *Cucurbita maxima*
Pear-shaped orange rind with green streaks. Sweet & nutty fine-grained flesh for baking.
- 25 **Long Island Cheese** *Cucurbita moschata*
Medium-large pumpkin that's slightly flattened and ribbed. Buff color fruit has deep-orange flesh that's great for pie.
- ? **Pink Banana**
Large, long winter squash (up to 3') good for baking.
- 8 **Pumpkin – Small Sugar**
Orange, slightly ribbed 7 inch fruits with smooth textured flavorful flesh. Great for pies.
- 8 **Spaghetti** *Cucurbita pepo*
Heirloom. Ripens to pale yellow. Inside flesh is nutty flavored, lightly sweet and stringy and is often used as a spaghetti substitute.
- 28 **Waltham Butternut** *Cucurbita pepo*
Classic, large butternut variety bears large fruit atop vigorous vines. Nutty and sweet – best after storage.

Strawberries

- ? **Sea Scape**
Cross. Highly productive over a long season yielding large, delicious berries. Everbearing.

Tomatillos

Two plants needed to produce fruit

- 12 **Gigante** *Physalis philadelphica*
Large round fruits that are sweeter than most tomatillos. Ripens earlier.
- 20 **Mexican Strain**
Larger fruit with more savory flavor
- 16 **Tomatillo**
Sweet, round fruits small to medium in size

Tomatoes

Solanum Lycopersicum

- 29 **4th of July** *Solanum Lycopersicum*
Hybrid. Indeterminate. Early ripening, 4-oz red tomato good for slicing. Produces all summer.
- 5 **Abe Lincoln**
Indeterminate. Heirloom. Red tomato
- 5 **African Queen**
Heirloom. Indeterminate. Produces heavy crops of large (1-2 lb) pink fruits that are slightly fluted beefsteaks with red flesh and rich flavors.
- 3 **Alaskan Fancy**
Early pear-shaped plum with luscious flavors. Determinate.
- 4 **Amish Paste**
Indeterminate. Suitable for both paste and slicing. Acorn shaped red tomato with thick flesh and few seeds
- 4 **Ana Russian**
Heirloom. Indeterminate. Pinkish-red oxheart shaped fruit are large and juicy with sweet tomato flavor.
- 18 **Berkeley Tie-dye Pink**
Indeterminate. Compact plants produce beautiful 8-12 oz fruit with rich and sweet tomato flavor. Port-wine colored with metallic green stripes
- 20 **Better Boy**
Hybrid. Indeterminate. Thrives in most climates due to good disease resistance. Up to 16oz red fruit.
- 22 **Big Beef**
Hybrid. Indeterminate. Beefsteak type tomato that is highly disease-resistant and tolerates cooler climates.

- 4 **Big Rainbow**
Heirloom. Indeterminate. Huge beefsteak type yellow tomato with bright red streaks.
- 20 **Black Cherry**
Indeterminate. Sweet and robust. Fruits are purplish-brown in color, high yielding and known for delicious flavor.
- 43 **Black Krim**
Heirloom. Indeterminate. Russian tomato almost black in color with green shoulders. 12-oz globe shape have uniquely pleasant salty flavor.
- 9 **Black Vernissage**
Heirloom. Indeterminate. Ukrainian saladette variety. Mahogany w/green stripes. Can be used for sauce. Productive
- 20 **Campari Red Cherry**
Indeterminate. Sweet with good acid. Produces golf ball size tomatoes on clusters.
- 4 **Carbon**
Heirloom. Indeterminate. Blocky, 10-14 oz fruit that's deep brick red with dark green shoulders. Good flavor.
- 10 **Carol Chyko's Big Paste**
Heirloom. Indeterminate. Large red/pink fruit good for slicing or sauce
- 8 **Chadwick Cherry**
Heirloom. Indeterminate. Vigorous plants produce 1" red fruit. Highly productive. Needs staking.
- 4 **Chef's Choice Pink**
Hybrid. Indeterminate. Large pink beefsteak variety with good sugar/acid balance. Great for slicing or paste.
- 5 **Cherokee Carbon**
Indeterminate. Medium-large fruit that's black with streaks. Color mutation of Cherokee Purple
- 5 **Cherokee Green**
Indeterminate. Medium-large fruit that's lime green and chartreuse. Color mutation of Cherokee Purple.
- 22 **Cherokee Purple**
Heirloom. Indeterminate. Relatively short vines produce medium-large, flattened globe fruits that are dusky pink with dark shoulders.
- 5 **Cherry Falls**
Determinante. Compact cherry tomato grows well in containers or hanging baskets with vines up to 18" tall. Vigorous plants produce sweet fruit.
- 2 **Copia**
Indeterminate. Large, yellow-orange beefsteak type
- 25 **Costoluto Genovese**
Italian heirloom. Indeterminate. Deeply lobed flat tomato good for sauce or eating. Rich flavor.

Tomatoes cont.

- 6 Cuostralee**
Indeterminate. French Heirloom with large ribbed red beefsteak variety. Old fashioned tomato flavor
- 10 Druzba**
Heirloom. Indeterminate. Clusters of deep red 4" tomatoes have robust flavor and juiciness.
- 24 Early Girl**
Hybrid. Indeterminate. Early red tomato.
- 8 Earliroughe**
Determinante. Short-season canning variety produces medium-sized fruit on 3' plants.
- 10 Esmeralda Golosina**
Heirloom. Indeterminate. Rare variety produces 5-10oz green tomatoes that are incredibly sweet.
- 10 Get Stuffed**
Indeterminate. Red & gold striped tomato that's hollow – perfect for stuffing. Delicious flavor.
- 15 Giant Buffalo Heart**
Heirloom. Indeterminate. Deep pink large heart-shaped tomato from Poland with rich flavor. Good yields.
- 5 Green Pineapple**
Indeterminate. 10 oz. Slightly flattened green tomato with yellow streaks. Rich tropical flavor.
- 3 Gregori's Altai**
Heirloom. Indeterminate. Siberian variety with tall plants producing 8-12 oz pink/red beefsteak tomatoes. High yield.
- 5 Hillbilly**
Heirloom. Indeterminate. Produces large ribbed orange-yellow fruit with red streaks. Delicious tropical flavors.
- 10 Hungarian Heart**
Indeterminate. Large pink oxheart variety with robust flavors.
- 10 Indigo Apple**
Indeterminate. Pendant clusters of 4oz fruits that are black, dark plum & mahogany.
- 5 Kalman's Hungarian Pink**
Indeterminate. Heirloom. Meaty, dark pink long fruit good for slicing or sauce.
- 10 Large Red Cherry**
Indeterminate. Sweet, bite-sized red tomatoes.

Tomatoes cont.

4 **Long Keeper**

Semi-determinate. Orange/red tomatoes that can keep for up to 3 months.

3 **Lucky Tiger**

Indeterminate. Dark green cherry with red striping. Tangy, sweet & complex flavors.

5 **Mama Leone**

Indeterminate. Red 6oz paste tomato with good flavor and few seeds.

4 **Marino's Roma**

Determinate. Rich flavored plum-shaped paste.

4 **Marizol Purple**

Heirloom. Indeterminate. German large, pink beefsteak variety with purple tint and sweet flavor. Vigorous with high yields.

5 **Oaxacan Jewel**

Indeterminate. Yellow beefsteak with red streaks.

10 **Orange Russian**

Indeterminate. Heart-shaped fruit that is orange/red with yellow and pink mottling. Very tall vines, ripens mid-late season.

6 **Patty's Striped Red**

Heirloom. Indeterminate. Yellow beefsteak variety with pink and red stripes. Low acid.

17 **Paul Robeson**

Heirloom. Indeterminate. Russian tomato bears med-large fruit with complex delicious smoky flavor. Maroon with green shoulders.

5 **Peacevine Cherry**

Indeterminate. Sweet clusters of red tomatoes. De-hybridized version of Sweet 100. Very prolific.

10 **Pineapple**

Heirloom. Indeterminate. Huge, yellow-orange tomatoes with red streaks and marbled flesh. Mild flavor with good yields.

11 **Pink Tiger**

Indeterminate cherry. Elongated fruit striped fire engine red and gold.

5 **Polish Linguisa**

Heirloom. Indeterminate. Huge sausage-shaped meaty paste tomatoes with firm flesh and few seeds. Very sweet flavor.

4 **Pruden's Purple**

Heirloom. Indeterminate. Large 1 lb. Fruit is dark pink with ridged shoulders. Good flavor and few seeds.

Tomatoes cont.

Solanum Lycopersicum

- 10 **Purple Russian (aka Ukrainian Purple)**
Heirloom. Indeterminate. Prolific producer of 3 to 4" purple/green fruit. Good for sauce, salad or salsa
- 3 **Queen of the Night**
Indeterminate, salad type. Brush strokes of indigo on red fruit; vermilion color inside.
- 5 **Russian 117**
Red, heart-shaped tomato known for its flavor and juiciness. Indeterminate
- 10 **Rutgers**
Indeterminate. Also known as Jersey, this beefsteak type has excellent balance of acidity and sugar.
- 15 **San Marzano**
Heirloom. Indeterminate. Paste tomato known for its old-world flavor and color. Excellent for sauce.
- 4 **San Marzano Lungo #2**
Newer selection of famous paste tomato. Heavy producer.
- 3 **Siberia**
Heirloom. Determinate. Russian variety that produces clusters of 4 oz tomatoes with delicious flavors. Good for shorter growing season.
- 5 **Southern Nights**
Heirloom. Indeterminate. Purple/brown, fluted Russian beefsteak with bold, complex flavors. Good disease resistance.
- 9 **Speckled Roman**
Heirloom. Indeterminate. Paste tomato that is dark red with gold stripes. Few seeds, rich color and flavor makes this great for sauce.
- 15 **SteakHouse**
Indeterminate. Hybrid. Huge beefsteak tomatoes with classic tomato flavor
- 40 **Sungold**
Hybrid. Indeterminate. One of the most popular cherry varieties. Abundant crop of dark gold tomatoes atop vigorous vines. Sweet/ flavorful.
- 19 **Sweetie**
Indeterminate. Clusters of low acid/high sugar cherry tomatoes.
- 2 **Terra Cotta**
Indeterminate. Honey-brown skin with orange/pink flesh. Incredible flavor.

Tomatoes cont.

- 7 **Veranda Red Cherry**
Hybrid. Determinate. Perfect for containers, this dwarf cherry tomato has good yields and sweet flavors. Foot tall plants great for small spaces.
- 10 **Vinson Watts**
Indeterminate. Heirloom. Large pink fruits with good flavor and balance.
- 2 **White Tomesol**
Indeterminate. Heirloom. Cream colored fruit bursting with fragrance and flavor. Half pound fruit with excellent yield
- 9 **Yellow Pear**
Produces masses of 1-2" pear shaped fruits. Great for snacking.
