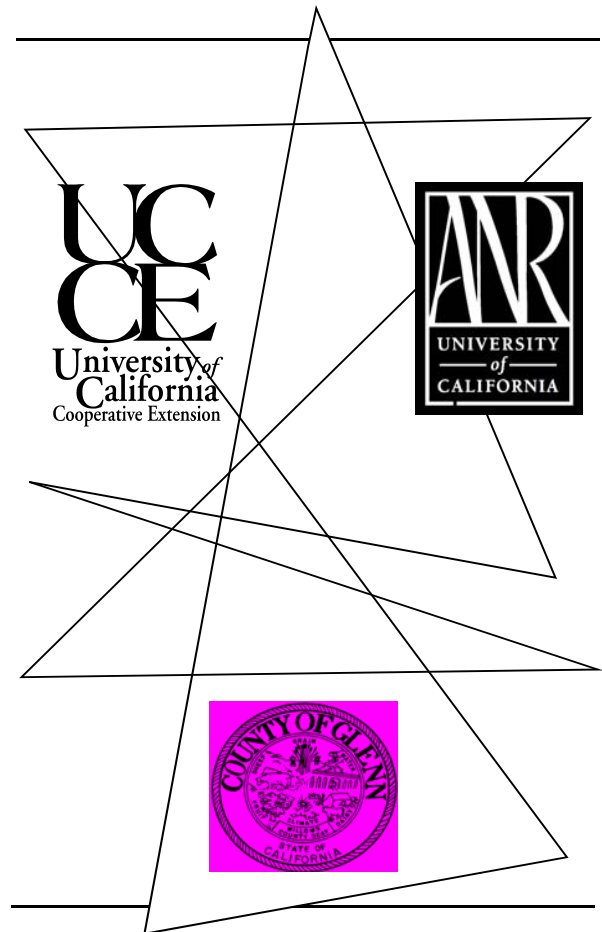

RESOURCES AND SERVICES PROVIDED

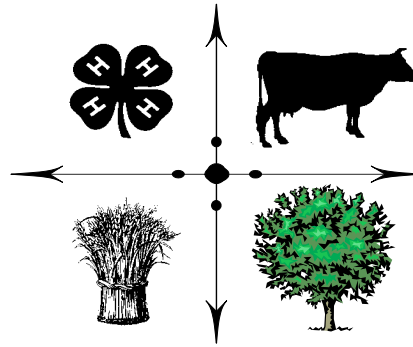
Grower Meetings - Educational meetings with up-to-date information dealing with production issues.

Applied Research - Local field experiments with farmers and ranchers testing varieties, fertilization, cultural and pest management practices, etc. on various field crops, rangeland, orchards and livestock.

Newsletters - You may subscribe to newsletters written by our staff.

Insect/Plant/Weed Identification - If we can't identify it, we can send it to UC Davis for identification.

Video Library - A large number of educational videos covering a wide range of topics are available.



Publications - A large variety of free and priced publications are available through Glenn County Cooperative Extension. A catalog is available.

Crop Water Use - Growers interested in crop water use (evapotranspiration) may request to receive weekly weather printouts from our CIMIS weather station located here in Orland from March to October. In addition, weekly evapotranspiration rates are printed in local newspapers.

4-H Youth Program - The 4-H program in Glenn County is available to all youth ages 5 - 19. We have 125+ volunteer leaders teaching projects such as beef, guide dogs, sports shooting safety, cooking, avian and more. The Special Olympics program has been assumed by Glenn County 4-H. Older members and leaders hold monthly activities for the handicapped.

Home Economics & Consumer Program - Advice on canning, freezing, money management and many other home economics topics are available.

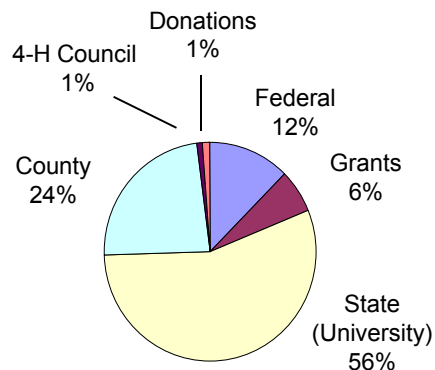
Parent Express - A series of monthly newsletters for expectant parents covering baby's first twelve months (available in English and Spanish). A toddler series is also available bi-monthly.

Extension Notes - Columns in local newspapers are written by our advisor staff and cover timely topics including current information on crop and livestock production and backyard pruning, insects, vegetable gardening and more.

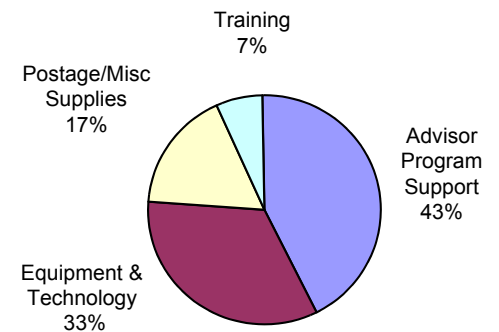
Satellite Programming - Satellite downlinking is available to bring educational programming to the area.
